The Children's Hearing made the decision(s) for the following reasons:

- The Panel heard many positive comments on Paul's behaviour and attitudes from all agencies.
- Everyone was in agreement, however, that there were many issues in Paul's life to be addressed namely - anger management and rejection of authority.
- Recent circumstances have led Paul to think that he can control situations around him.
- Moorhouse is presently meeting Paul's educational & welfare needs. A 6 week period of further assessment will allow a clearer picture to emerge of all of Paul's needs.
- It was clear to all that Paul & his family are very close.
- Contact with [REDACTED] & siblings will take place at discretion of S/O & in conjunction with Moorhouse.
- The Panel commended Paul on his mature, calm approach to the Hearing.
- A Safeguarder was not felt to be necessary.
