The family reside in a local authority house in the Barrhead area and have done so since 1997. The property is over crowded with only two bedrooms however the family have adapted other spaces to use to accommodate the needs of the family. It is clear [] and Craig take pride in their house and have adapted outdoor spaces for seating areas, etc. The property is well maintained and tidy with many modern comforts. A previous report noted the family home to be a busy house, with friends and family often dropping in to ... Craig also has relatives who live close by, ... [] and Craig are not currently in employment and the family are in receipt of state benefits...
