Thank you for your subject access request for records relating to your client Alan Soave. Unfortunately, we have been unable to locate any information relating to your request. It appears that Mr Soave stayed at institutions that were not run by the Church of Scotland.

The Polwarth Terrace Home was run by the Royal Scottish Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children, now known as Children 1st. Children 1st is still in operation and may hold any surviving records. (This institution is sometimes confused with the Lord and Lady Polwarth Home, which was run by the Church of Scotland and for which we hold quite full records, but I have checked the records for this home just in case and we do not have any pertaining to Mr Soave.)

I've been unable to identify an Inverickney Children's Hotel but wonder if this could be the Coble Haugh children's home in Inverurie? If this may be the case, this home was run by Aberdeenshire Council and if any records survive, Aberdeenshire City Archives would hold them.
