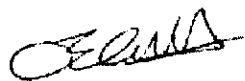

I phoned Mr. Serapiglia (6.50 p.m. – 9.10 p.m.) on 16th December 2013.

A very lengthy conversation, lasting 2 hours 10 minutes, took place.

Mr Serapiglia explained in great detail the events which had taken place during his school years; he continued by explaining that he had counselling as a result of his school experiences. He wanted his case against the Sisters of Cluny (Girvan) and the Marist Brothers (St. Columba's) to be resolved to his complete satisfaction. (Money/Compensation mentioned).

Mr. Serapiglia has engaged McCluskey, Brown, Solicitors, to pursue his case for compensation. He has also asked an Edinburgh MP to assist him (no name given) in his pursuit of satisfaction.

I reiterated that (he had been informed of this in his earlier phone call) the Diocese of Galloway was not responsible for complaints raised by individuals against religious orders. Advised that his solicitor should seek to pursue his case with respective orders. It was agreed that he should not contact Bishop Cunningham or myself again, as his case was now the responsibility of his legal team.

21st December 2013

Mr. Serapiglia phoned to say his legal adviser had sent a letter to say he would no longer represent him. He wanted to read the contents of the letter to me. I refused and again repeated that he should not contact me again. He then said he was going to the press. I told him I would not listen to any more of his personal grievance and cut short the call.

Mr. Serapiglia wrote to Bishop Cunningham, letter dated 22nd December 2013, and Bishop Cunningham replied to him in a letter dated 31st December 2013. (He had previously phoned Fr. David Borland, St. Andrew's, Dumfries, on 22nd December

2013 – Fr. Borland's e-mail to Fr. McFadden dated 22/12/13 refers) [Copies of all this correspondence are attached to this report].

Subject: Child abuse report

I had a telephone call from a guy called 'Enzo' tonight who says he was abused by the Marist Brothers and the Sisters of Cluny – both in the 70's/80's. He now lives in Kilmarnock, but when he lived in Paisley he spoke to Philip Tartaglia and John Tormey. He also says he has spoken by telephone to a Kilmarnock priest who has said three times he would go round and visit him to talk about it but he has yet to appear – he didn't give a name and I didn't want to 'interrogate' him.

He has reported both events to the police and they are coming to see him again to take further statements. He has spoken to the Marist whom he says told him to 'get a lawyer', the Sisters told him to call the Bishop and then hung up on him – or so he says.

I advised him to write to the Bishop with an outline of his allegations and said that the Bishop might meet him to discuss. He is talking of a 'cash settlement for closure'.

Just thought you should be aware of what is going on.

Dear Bishop John,

Further to a conversation on the telephone with Fr. David Berland, (Sunday Evening) 22/12/13. I have been advised by him to write you because I was asking him a question on how to become a non Catholic. As Father ask me why? my reply was, that I suffered from various types of abuse from Schools I attended as a child.

The first School was called St Joseph's Convent ran by Nuns where I first experienced Physical, Mental, and Emotional abuse. As I was only five year old and stayed until the school closed down three year later. This School was located in Girvan, close to barhill from what I remember my mum saying.

The second School (St Columbas College, Largs) ran by the Marist Order is where I received all three types above and also Sexual abuse. That went on for another three years.

I spoke with Bishop Tartaglia in a meeting that was held at St. Minens, Paisley and at the time brought my Counsellor with me to ask advise, Bishop Tartaglia

at the time advise myself to confront the Police and the
Marist Order, Denvonhill Street, Glasgow, where another
meeting was ^{held} made to discuss this further. The Marist
Order asked me to get intouch with the Police and consult
a lawyer, and I did.

After two year of more stress added to the bad memories
I am now in receipt of a letter from my lawyer to tell me
that I have been beaten with time Bar. I have just
recently reported the first abuse case to Kilnmeck
Police and want the C.I.D to get back intouch with
me

I am 46 years old, and worked through diffrent doctors
and Counsellors to get to where I am now. I would
like closure in all these bad memories so that I can
forgive these humans that carried out these actsof evil
I would love to move forward but I can't, until I
get true Justice in God.

I am sorry to hear of your experiences, as detailed in your letter of 22nd December.

As you are aware, there are strict procedures to be followed in allegations of abuse, and I can only advise you, as did Archbishop Tartaglia, to remain faithful to these procedures: namely, to contact the relevant authorities, i.e. the Religious Congregation, the Marist Brothers and the police.

Those entrusted with safeguarding in the Church are committed to ensuring that justice is done in cases of abuse, and so support all victims in following faithfully the agreed procedures. It has been shown that only by being faithful to due process can it be hoped for any closure to take place. In the situations to which you refer contact must be made with the Marist Brothers and the Religious Congregation to whom the allegations are directed. This is the only way to address your situation, and so I ask you to do this.

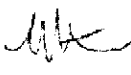

I enclose two Reports for the CRSSC. Please accept my apologies for the delay in reporting these two cases, but there has obviously been a hiccup in our systems.

As you know our Provincial House is based in the Netherlands and so each country in the Province has to have delegates for the different areas of a Provincial's work. I share safeguarding responsibilities in Scotland with our [REDACTED]. While I am happy to be the named Link person and attend meetings and do the paperwork, [REDACTED] is far more effective at dealing directly with complainants and victims than I would be. It is now obvious that this set-up has led to problems of communication between [REDACTED] and me. Additionally, [REDACTED] had some questions about the necessity of reporting to CRSSC and breaching confidentiality – questions that, I am glad to say, we have cleared up.

It was only when we were holding a Case Conference last week, at which [REDACTED] was present with our Legal Advisor, that I realised I had not reported these two cases. While the ES case dates back quite some time, the [REDACTED] one surfaced only this year.

I would be happy to discuss any aspect of the two cases or of this letter. However, please note that I will be out of the country between Wednesday 21st and Saturday 24th November. Ronnie and I are attending the first Safeguarding Meeting of our Province. I shall be around next week.

Information

Complainant was a pupil during the late 1970s at St Columba's College, Largs, a boarding preparatory school conducted by the Marist Brothers. He alleges that he was subjected to sexual, physical and emotional abuse by the above-named Brothers both in the dormitory and the classroom.

Allegations were first made to [REDACTED] at the end of 2009 and a meeting was set up. However, ES cancelled agreed dates three times before coming to a meeting in March 2010 with his counsellor. During this meeting ES spoke of also being sexually abused by his brother and a friend when he was age 14. The consequence of all the abuse he experienced has been a very troubled life.

ES has had a further meeting with [REDACTED] which our Provincial, [REDACTED] also attended. An agreement was reached that the Marist Brothers would fund a series of therapy sessions for ES. Contrary to previous denials of intention, it now seems that ES is pursuing a claim for negligence against the Marist Brothers.

[I must apologise for the delay in reporting this case. It was only when the case was discussed at a Case Conference with our legal advisor last week that I realised I had the details on file but had not reported them.]
