presented at Kirkintilloch Police Office to report that his had assaulted him. He informed the officers that he is 16 years old and under supervision. Standby records shoe that he is 15 years old. Police confirmed this with (n).

Police requesting a check of records for background information.

CPR negative - Previous CP2 12/06/09 - No Further Action.

Please call back and advise.

SUBSEQUENT INVESTIGATION AND ACTION BY STANDBY SERVICE:

Pass to SW Ann Anderson - Care 1st checked. Noted concerns re relationship between and Confirmed that subject to supervision, supports to family outlined such as respite which declined, discussions about going missing. Does not seem to be many family supports local, dad's sister is mentioned at beginning of August and there was the intention of going there for a long weekend.

Telephone call to PO has presented at the police office saying his mother threw a pumice stone at him. He has been out and on returning home an argument started between him and mum which resulted in her throwing pumice stone. has 2 minor abrasions to his upper chest and right side of face. He did not require medical attention. has come in with a friend and his mother has said that can stay there overnight. mother has said that she does not want this to happen as what's saying is fabrication and his friend is colluding with him. mum wants him home.

Discussed with PC re interviews - she advised that police want to take a statement now from I said about joint interview between AP and FPU taking place later on Monday given the time of night. PO repeated that they wanted to take a statement and eventually it was agreed that I would discuss with TL whilst police pursued discussion re aunt. At this point PC advised that had now indicated that he would go home whereas initially he had said he did not want to and did not feel safe. partner is at home. has not been drinking.

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Observations / Case Notes

Discussed with TL [REDACTED] who advised that [REDACTED] should not return home pending further investigation into his allegation and injuries and that a joint interview should take place on Monday by AT and police - thereafter called PC [REDACTED] to discuss as above. She agreed to pursue [REDACTED] perhaps going to his aunt's and seeking agreement from his mum, she advised that they would take a statement in front of his aunt. PC [REDACTED] agreed to call Standby in due course. Advised PC [REDACTED] that CPR - negative.

01.31 - telephone call from PO [REDACTED] - initially taken by a colleague and PC [REDACTED] indicated that they would not interview [REDACTED] tonight. Spoke with PC [REDACTED] and she advised that [REDACTED] is going to the home of [REDACTED] mum. [REDACTED] mum had agreed this. [REDACTED] lives at [REDACTED] Place DOB [REDACTED]. Care 1st check - no recent information. Past information suggests domestic abuse, alcohol misuse - [REDACTED] previously on supervision. Advised PC [REDACTED] of above and agreed that [REDACTED] go there for the duration of the night and referrals to AT and FPU be made for the morning.

THE VICTIM AND SUSPECT HAVE NEVER BEEN MARRIED. THE VICTIM STATES THEY WERE IN A RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN 2007 AND 2010 DURING WHICH TIME THE CO-HABITED AT LOCUS. THEY HAVE CONTINUED TO LIVE AT THIS ADDRESS SINCE THE CONCLUSION OF THEIR RELATIONSHIP AS THE VICTIM HAS BEEN CARING FOR THE SUSPECT WHO HAS HAD VARIOUS HEALTH PROBLEMS WHICH HAVE INCLUDED BREAST CANCER AND DEPRESSION.

THE HAVE NO CHILDREN FROM THIS UNION HOWEVER THE VICTIM HAS A DAUGHTER FROM A PREVIOUS RELATIONSHIP [REDACTED] WHO RESIDES WITH HER MOTHER. THE SUSPECT HAS 4 SONS FROM A PREVIOUS MARRIAGE, 2 OF WHICH ARE ADULTS.

SUMMARY OF EVENTS:

ABOUT 1715 HOURS ON SUNDAY 16TH SEPTEMBER 2012 THE POLICE WITNESSES [REDACTED] WERE ON UNIFORM DUTY WHEN THEY ATTENDED AT [REDACTED] IN RELATION TO AN ONGOING MISSING PERSON ENQUIRY.

ON ARRIVAL AT LOCUS THE POLICE WITNESSES MET WITH THE VICTIM [REDACTED] AND HIS EX-PARTNER, THE SUSPECT [REDACTED] (MOTHER OF THE MISSING PERSON). THE POLICE WITNESSES WERE ALLOWED ENTRY TO THE LOCUS AND ON SPEAKING WITH THE SUSPECT IT BECAME APPARENT THAT SHE WAS UNWELCOMING OF

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THE POLICE ATTENDANCE AND WELL UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL. THE POLICE WITNESSES ATTEMPTED TO OBTAIN INFORMATION FOR THE MISSING PERSON ENQUIRY FROM THE SUSPECT HOWEVER SHE WAS AT TIMES UN-COOPERATIVE.

AT 1800 HOURS THE POLICE WITNESSES [REDACTED] OF THE STRATHCLYDE POLICE SUPPORT UNIT ATTENDED AT LOCUS IN ORDER TO CARRY OUT A THOROUGH SEARCH OF THE PREMISES FOR THE MISSING PERSON. THE SUSPECT BECAME IRATE AT THIS THEIR AND BEGAN SHOUTING AND SWEARING AT THE POLICE WITNESSES USING PHRASES SUCH AS 'YOU'RE ALL FUCKIN WANKERS' AND 'THEY FUCKIN ARSEHOLES ARE TRYING TO INTIMIDATE ME'. THE POLICE WITNESSES [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] WARNED THE SUSPECT REGARDING HER BEHAVIOUR HOWEVER SHE CONTINUED TO SHOUT PHRASES SUCH AS AND 'FUCKIN ARSEHOLES'. SHE WAS AGAIN WARNED AND ACCOMPANIED BY THE VICTIM [REDACTED] SHE ESCORTED HER INTO THE LIVING ROOM AREA OF THE LOCUS IN ORDER TO CALM HER DOWN. THE SUSPECT CONTINUED TO SHOUT AND SWEAR; NOW DIRECTING HER ABUSE TOWARDS THE VICTIM [REDACTED] WHO WAS ATTEMPTING TO PLACATE HER, SHOUTING PHRASES SUCH AS 'YOU GET TO FUCK' AND 'AM GONNA FUCKIN GET YOU'. THE POLICE WITNESSES WERE RELUCTANT TO ARREST THE SUSPECT AT THIS TIME DUE TO THE ONGOING MISSING PERSON ENQUIRY AND AGAIN MANAGED TO PLACATE THE SUSPECT. THE POLICE WITNESS [REDACTED] ATTENDED OUTWITH THE DWELLING HOUSE IN ORDER TO RECEIVE AN URGENT MESSAGE REGARDING THE ENQUIRY. THE SUSPECT BECAME IRATE AGAIN AND MADE HER WAY WITHIN THE HALLWAY OF LOCUS WHERE THE POLICE WITNESS [REDACTED] OBSERVED HER TO LUNGE FORWARD AND STRIKE THE VICTIM [REDACTED] TO THE HEAD WITH HER HAND. THE POLICE WITNESS [REDACTED] RE-ENTERED THE LOCUS AND ALONG WITH THE POLICE WITNESS [REDACTED] TOOK HOLD OF THE SUSPECT AND REMOVED HER TO THE LIVING ROOM AREA. AS THEY DID THIS THE SUSPECT AGAIN LUNGED FORWARD AGAIN ATTEMPTING TO STRIKE THE VICTIM [REDACTED] TO THE HEAD.

THE POLICE WITNESSES RESTRAINED THE SUSPECT; HOWEVER A DECISION WAS MADE NOT TO INFORM HER SHE WAS UNDER ARREST DUE TO THE LIKELIHOOD THAT IT WOULD COMPROMISE THE MISSING PERSON ENQUIRY.

THE SUSPECT THEN REQUESTED THAT SHE BE ALLOWED UPSTAIRS WITHIN THE LOCUS IN ORDER TO USE THE TOILET. THE VICTIM [REDACTED] LEFT THE LOCUS AT THIS TIME. AS SHE HAS NUMEROUS HEALTH PROBLEMS SHE WAS ALLOWED THIS REQUEST HOWEVER SHE AGAIN CONTINUED TO SHOUT AND SWEAR AT THE POLICE WITNESSES USING PHRASES SUCH AS 'FUCKIN WANKERS' AND 'AM FUCKIN KILL MYSELF'. THE SUSPECT WAS THEN CUFFED TO THE REAR AND REMOVED FROM LOCUS BY THE POLICE WITNESSES [REDACTED]

THE SUSPECT WAS CONVEYED TO MARYHILL POLICE OFFICE PRIOR TO BEING CONVEYED TO LONDON ROAD POLICE OFFICE WHERE SHE WAS PROCESSED IN THE NORMAL MANNER.

AT 1040 HOURS WITHIN LONDON ROAD POLICE OFFICE THE SUSPECT WAS CAUTIONED AND CHARGED AS LIBELLED BY THE POLICE WITNESS [REDACTED] IN THE PRESENCE OF THE POLICE WITNESS [REDACTED] SHE REPLIED NOT GUILTY TO BOTH CHARGES.

THE POLICE WITNESS STRUTHERS NOTED A STATEMENT FROM THE VICTIM HOWEVER HE WAS UN-COOPERATIVE AND REFUSED TO INCLUDE WITHIN THE STATEMENT THE PHRASES THE SUSPECT WAS SHOUTING AND ALSO THE ACTIONS SHE TOOK WHEN SHE STUCK HIM.

He also related that both he and his mother had been verbally abusive towards each other - this happens regularly, the only difference being that the worker was present today. He also informed workers that Area Team had investigated the allegations that he had made re his brothers, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] his mother he stated did not believe him. According to [REDACTED] he finds it difficult to discuss his feelings (his psychiatrist compared him to an onion - a number of layers). He talked of not feeling like [REDACTED] due to the way his mum treats him, and that she had told him that he was only here due 'to a burst jonnie'.

It is evident that there are serious relationship difficulties within the family that are not resolved - [REDACTED] clearly wishes to be accommodated and can be manipulative (by his own admission he can be a compulsive liar). However, re tonight - there was another adult in the house [REDACTED] mum's ex-partner) who is sober. [REDACTED] had been drinking, in conjunction with her meds she had fallen asleep - there was therefore no prospect of a physical confrontation by either party although [REDACTED] stated that he would not stay, he was calm. [REDACTED] was advised that if [REDACTED] leaves, then to contact police and report him as a missing person (which he agreed to do).

DETAILS OF PROBLEM AS GIVE BY REFERRER:

[REDACTED] contacted Standby. Her voice was slurred. She demanded that [REDACTED] is removed from her care tonight. Writer could hear a male voice in the background and asked who this is. It is [REDACTED] support worker from Bamardos. Writer then spoke with him [REDACTED] who informed the writer that the relationship between mother and son has been tense for some considerable time. When he arrived this evening mum had been drinking and both were threatening to harm each other. He took [REDACTED] out for an hour or so, and upon returning she has consumed more alcohol and has threatened to smash his face in. He in turn is equally aggressive towards her. Father is currently in Kent. No family locally. Friends will not assist because when they have in the past [REDACTED] has sent police to their homes or arrived at their homes drunk (according to [REDACTED]). Even so, [REDACTED] are claiming they cannot contact anyone. [REDACTED] was advised that records will be checked, but [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] must attempt to identify alternative accommodation tonight.

Emergency accommodation YP.

He felt isolated at home due to his mother having lost him friends through her threats.

It was pointed out to [REDACTED] that he was extremely calm as was his mother, therefore, in the circumstances there was no need for him to be accommodated. [REDACTED] agreed to this, however, when workers were speaking to his mother (in the lounge), he came in, as he had changed his mind - he then left - but was persuaded to return to the house. In his room he related that he did not feel safe and that his mother had slapped him in the face earlier (there were no bruises) - he was advised that he could contact police re this, but that the Area Team would be informed.
