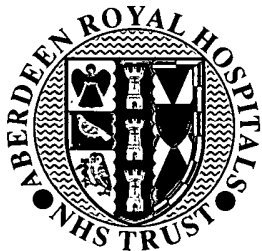

He continues on his Pulmicort in a dose of 500 ug bd via nebuliser.

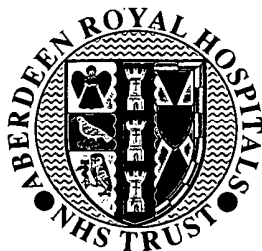
Clinical examination was unremarkable. I have not made any changes in his current medication and have merely called him back for review in four months.

I reviewed Lee at Dr Russell's Asthma Clinic recently. Mum thinks that he is fine since he has been in the clinic two months ago. He has not required Ventolin until two days ago because he had a cold which caused his wheeze and cough.

His current medication is Pulmicort 500 micrograms twice daily via a nebuliser and Ventolin only when it is required.

On examination today, the chest is completely clear. I made no change in his current medication and he is to be review in two months.
