Examination revealed that he was tender over the mid-cervical and upper thoracic spine and was tender over the occiput. Neurological examination was entirely normal as were x-rays.

He was observed overnight during which time he was entirely stable. He was allowed home this morning with written head injury advice and no further follow-up has been arranged.

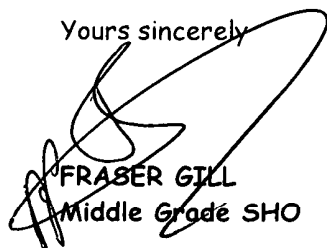

Thank you for referring Lee whom I saw today. He complains of intermittent pain in his right leg. Specifically he points to the front of his right knee although he also gets discomfort in the back of the knee.

On examination he had a full range of movements of his right hip. He also had a full range of movements of his right knee. He was tender over the attachment of the ligament patellae to the bottom pole of the patella.

Radiographs of his hip were normal. Radiographs of the knee show a small area of calcification at the lower pole of the patella and taken in conjunction with the clinical findings this is consistent with Sindig-Larsen-Johansson syndrome which is really a traction apophysitis and should ultimately resolve. I have reassured him. I don't need to see him again.

History of Presenting Complaint

This young man has previously been seen in the department with recurrent leg pain. He was fully investigated and nil was found.

His mother is concerned that he is having increasing pain in his lower limbs again, particularly in his left leg. This can be troublesome for a couple of days and then settle down with or without treatment with Paracetamol or Junior Ibuprofen.

On examination he has full movements of his hip joints, knee joints and ankle joints although he did have discomfort behind the left knee over his hamstrings.

I do not think there is anything major going on here but because of maternal anxiety I would be grateful for his assessment and advice on further management.

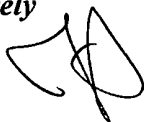

I reviewed this young man in Clinic today. It is now six weeks since he fell playing football and hyperflexed his left wrist. Clinically on initial presentation he had a scaphoid fracture and on follow-up appointment he had persistent tenderness in his anatomical snuffbox and on telescoping the thumb.

X-ray taken at second appointment was suggestive of a fracture across the waist of the scaphoid and he was, therefore, treated for a full six weeks in cast.

On review today there is no evidence of any anatomical snuffbox tenderness and there is no tenderness on palpation of the scaphoid or on telescoping his thumb. His hand was neurovascularly intact. I have counselled him in hand exercises today but otherwise discharged him from Clinic.

Lee is a seven year old boy with complex behavioural difficulties and social circumstances. He had been complaining to his Mum that his legs had been sore for two months. He had been seen by yourself two weeks previously and was given analgesia for the pain. He had been complaining of pains in his knees and also in his calf and shin and some pain in his wrist. Mum thought that this was due to cramp. Over the past few days his pain had become worse, he was complaining of pain both in the morning and at night and the pain was waking him up. Calpol was not helping. He had also been complaining of some sore heads and said he had some difficulty walking.

There is a family history of arthritis on Mum's side.

On examination he was afebrile and well. He completely refused to move his left knee. He said it was extremely painful. There was no obvious abnormality seen on his knee.

He was admitted to the ward for observation because of concerns that he might have a septic arthritis. However his bloods were entirely normal, including a CRP <10 an ESR of 14 and a completely normal white cell count and haemoglobin. His ASO titer is awaited.

When he was actually reviewed later on that day he had no pain at all in his knees and a full range of movement. He was however still complaining of pain in his left wrist but could move it very freely.

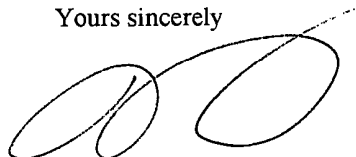
The next day when he was examined there was again no obvious abnormality of his arms and legs. When we asked him to walk he started to limp slightly.

However, when I asked him if he could run or indeed hop, he ran extremely fast with no evidence of a limp at all and hopped well on both legs. His gait was entirely normal.

He had X-rays performed when he was first admitted which showed no bony abnormality. He was therefore allowed home. We have said to Mum that we thought this was probably behavioural in origin and nothing serious was going on. However we had arranged to see Lee back in the clinic but again he failed to attend and I see that has been a recurrent problem for him. I have not organised any further follow up in view of his persistent failure to attend. However, if you have on going concerns about his leg pain please could you get in touch with me and we will organise for Lee to be seen, even if that involves contacting the Social Work and asking them to bring him to his appointments.

This boy has had multiple non attendance's at the Children's Hospital despite what appeared to be ongoing problems with constipation and also more recently with headache. In the past he has also defaulted from appointments with Mr Youngson. The problem may be compounded by the fact that I believe mother is a methadone addict.

I wonder if you could try and make contact with Lee's Health Visitor as I would be grateful for any information which helps me decide whether I should just leave things alone or whether further intervention to get Lee to Clinic is required.

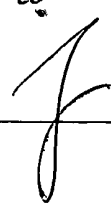
