Many thanks for your letter of the 21st of January. I think this letter probably crossed with my letter to Dr Wiseman of the 31st of January. You will see from that that Lee has in fact failed to turn up for appointments in the Children's Hospital in August, September, October and again in January of this year. I note also that when he was under the surgeons there are multiple non-attendances.

When he was last seen in the Children's Hospital the primary problem appeared to be one of constipation which, as far as I can gather, wasn't being consistently treated by his mother. Given the multiple non-attendances and mother's known medical problems I think probably the only way for me to see Lee would be for either the Health Visitor or the Social Worker to actually bring him and mother up to the clinic. Alternatively, if we feel that Lee is actually coming to harm as a result of his mother not complying with his medical treatment and his hospital attendances I could perhaps involve one of my colleagues in community child health if one feels there are child protection issues.

Could you perhaps get back to me on which of the above two issues you feel is most appropriate and I will make the necessary arrangements.

This young lad is due to be seen by yourself in your Medical Clinic on 31 January 2000. His mother has brought him along today in quite a state about, what she describes as a year long history of chronic headaches which has been leading to increased time off school. Unfortunately she says that each time a Doctor has been Lee it has been during her appointment and therefore no record of him being seen in the last year is in his notes.

Over the last week things have worsened and he now has headaches every day but it has also been associated with him feeling slightly tired and being off his food. His mother was in no way amenable to the suggestion that he may have a viral illness at the moment making his headaches worse and insisted on a second opinion from the hospital.

I believe this lad may have an underlying problem with migraines which has been exacerbated by a recent viral illness and therefore started him on Pizotifen syrup 500 mcg at night but due to parental insistence, I would be grateful for any help you can offer.

Diagnosis: Chronic Constipation
Treatment: Lactulose 15 mls pd, Senokot 20 mls pd

I reviewed Lee in Dr Bisset's Out Patient Clinic today for his chronic constipation. As you know, he was admitted six weeks ago to our wards for a clear out. Since discharge, mum reports he is having watery loose stools whenever she gives him the prescribed dose of Lactulose and Senokot, which becomes better without medication. He is also not eating very well and vomiting as long as he is on the medication. Therefore, mum keeps taking him off medication and he hasn't had any for the last week. There seems to be a problem with regular meals and regular toilet training, and quite often mum puts him in nappies overnight. We are currently trying to establish a ~~starch~~ chart, but mum didn't bring this in today. Overall, I have a feeling that the main problem are due to circumstances at home. I have advised mum again not to put him in nappies overnight and reinforced my previous advice regarding regular meals and regular toiletry afterwards and the importance of continuous treatment to prevent a build up of the stool load. I recommenced his treatment of Lactulose 15 ml bd and Senokot 20 mls bd and have arranged for a follow up appointment in six weeks time. If this should be unsuccessful, we will have to think about re-admission for a longer period this time.

Many thanks for asking me to see this boy who has had problems all his life with constipation and soiling. The problem, unfortunately, continues and it sounds as if Lee is generally very reluctant to go to the toilet. I think there probably isn't enough order in his life to get a good bowel training programme established at home. This doesn't bode well for further attempts at bowel clearout and training, but possibly now that Lee is older, he might be able to take control of things himself.

In the past, he has had Senokot and Lactulose, but I think it would be pointless just starting this as an out-patient and I have, therefore, put Lee on our waiting list for admission to ward 4 at the Children's Hospital for bowel clearout and toilet training. It is likely that he will be in the ward for at least two weeks. I have also arranged for him to have a plain abdominal x-ray.
