MHN discussed benefits of same but alongside talking type work and he was agreeable to this, he feels he was able to speak openly with mHN and is happy to do further apps so more info can be gathered and also to try alternative meds to see if it will help. he describes: lots of overthinking tends to internalise his emotions and look at what he has done wrong all the time- no self praise very little self worth and confidence- accepting of validation and reframing of thoughts can be irrational at times with his thinking and assume the worst at times leading to him feeling irritable and agitated these feelings worry him as he doesn't want to be a bad person but has a lot of negative thoughts no plan or intent to harm self but has tried in the past plan: p/t struggling to regulate some of his emotions and feels he needs something to dull/calm his over thinking and anxiety. we discussed fluoxetine and he was keen to trial same.
