Andrew presents few problems. He is doing well at Roineach Mhor and is the least affected of the three children by events at home. Although he is the one who is most likely to settle at home permanently it was felt that Christina should go home before him. If it was the other way around it might mean that any problems with Christina could also upset his chances of remaining at home.

Goals - Long Term/Short Term (before next Review)
