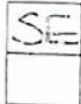

William informed me rather crossly that [REDACTED] had told him his mother was expecting another baby. When I asked him whether he was cross he said he wasn't. He then went on to talk about other things and said yet again how much he enjoyed being with the [REDACTED] and wanted to stay there. I introduced to William the idea of making a book about his life, so that he would know why and how he had come to live with [REDACTED]. I showed him a photocopy of 'My First Family Tree Book' and showed him how we might complete it over a period of time. Although quite interested William lost concentration after 10 minutes. [REDACTED] came in and William showed him the book. William then engaged in very reasonable, interesting conversation with [REDACTED] and myself for a while. I was struck by William's relaxed, open and warm manner with both [REDACTED] and the boys. [REDACTED] asked about contact arrangements with [REDACTED]. I advised that we were arranging contact with both during the summer holidays and Maureen Petrie would be in touch to make arrangements.
