Most of the access session was spent eating the huge amount of sweets parents had brought along - half of which were wasted. Suggested some fruit and less sweets might be more appropriate.

Mr Tarbett made some efforts to talk to all the children. William appeared less inclined to go and spend time with dad. Mr Tarbett tried to take [REDACTED] on his knee and talk to her but [REDACTED] was not interested and wriggled away. At one point Linda said 'is that you boyfriend mum' then to [REDACTED] 'is mum your girlfriend'. Mum and dad just laughed.

Informed Mr Tarbett and Ms Archer that as result of individual sessions and joint sessions that SWD would not be recommending that the children be returned to Mr Tarbett and Ms Archer as a couple. Mr Tarbett had continued to take no responsibility for children's reception into care and refused to accept any change was needed in the way which he cared for the children. As a result of individual sessions the possible option was put that if Ms Archer could set up independently with [REDACTED] that one or more of the children may be returned to her care. This would be dependent of assessment on her ability to care for the children alone.

Mr Tarbett said he would consult his solicitor. Ms Archer made no comment but was obviously listening carefully to what was said.

Mr Tarbett then became very abusive and aggressive told us to get out. Lucky we were still sitting there; if his sons had been there we would not. Mr Tarbett stated we were blackmailing him.
