Linda and Davy agreed with DRS of previous session 07.02.95.

Discussed contract (see attached).

Linda and Davy both refused to sign the contract as they disagreed with item 5.

Linda and Davy are not accepting any responsibility for children's RIC.

There was a long discussion around this issue again going over many past events.

When asked what their solution was to having the children returned - they had both discussed this previous to the session and both feel they have "no hope in hell" of getting the children back.

Davy felt SWD should be saying whether the children would be returned or not. He did not see the importance of sessions.

Davy then proceeded to discuss other families and children who he believed are worse than his. Also discussed being asked to leave his solicitor's office for no reason. The discussion then went on to Children's Hearing for [REDACTED] and disagreement about number of moves [REDACTED] has had. Discussion continued to be sidetracked from main issue.

Linda very annoyed about sessions felt they were getting nowhere.

Calum asked how they could convince the Panel that things had changed and the children could be returned.

Davy stated the panel would just take word of SWD and that nobody would change his way of things, SWD are only picking on his family.

Discussion then moved to children in care and respite care issues not related to work in hand.

Mr Tarbett and Ms Archer agreed the record of previous meeting 14.02.95 correct.

Discussed whether sessions should go ahead. Mr Tarbett and Ms Archer still feeling sessions are waste of time. Mr Tarbett still denying any problems or any responsibility for RIC. Linda stating she was not around at time of RIC; therefore, she has no responsibility for RIC.

Linda accepted there had been problems in the past. Why did Linda think the children were in care? Linda did not answer this.

Mr Tarbett again complaining sessions were getting nowhere. Advised them one of the areas we would look at was their relationship and past abuse/violence in this relationship.

Mr Tarbett very adamant not violent relationship - no police proof - no charges against him.

Linda did not deny their relationship had been violent. She spoke about time in Whitfield when her face had been badly bruised. Also the time when her teeth had been knocked out, although Davy stated he had just pushed her because she had attacked him with a knife. Davy then went on to say Linda had been charged on two occasions for assaulting him. Davy still denying their relationship was violent. Discussed difficulty of working on relationship problems if there was not honesty.

Advised couple that [REDACTED] had recently spoken about mum and dad fighting. Mum saying [REDACTED] had witnessed this but not [REDACTED]

Davy again changed subject by stating they were either getting the children back or not.

Calum asked if Davy felt there was nothing they could do to get children back. Davy stated they could say this and that but he felt things would revert back to what they were before if the children returned - the children would be their normal selves.

He again stated they were either getting children back or not, there is nothing wrong with the children and that they were just wasting their time attending sessions.

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He then went on to say the children are away for no reason - worse children than them still at home.

His solicitor had also told him the longer children in care, less chance of them returning to parents and that it is not fault of Davy and Linda but of Social Work Department.

Davy feels it is no use telling lies - he will bring the children up the way he wanted. Everything was fine before they went into care - they went to school, were fed and clean.

Raised some issues of his care eg leaving children at Social Work Department office to be taken to mum with no explanations, taking the children to Women's Aid Refuge to look for mum, putting children on the telephone to mum, saying that mum did not love them anymore.

Did Davy appreciate the effect this behaviour had on the children's emotional wellbeing. Davy felt these incidents had no effect, children were taken off him because of Social Worker.

Couple were asked directly if they wanted the children back, if so how much. Linda laughed, Davy stated that RIC was hurting the children worse than themselves. Linda stated [REDACTED] has only 10 years to go and he will return to them anyway.

Davy again stating he is not coming back to sessions.

Workers stating parents must acknowledge circumstances of past to move forward.

Davy stated there is no way he is looking into future. Linda terminated session saying they had other things to do.

Workers to discuss present situation with George Bowie SSW.

[REDACTED] reports her behaviour in house or when out with her or other members of the family is always good. Spoke to [REDACTED] about her behaviour previous evening after access when she had had a disagreement with [REDACTED] and had kicked Maureen Petrie's car, her behaviour quite uncontrollable. [REDACTED] looked very apprehensive and quite tearful so I explained she had already been told off but I would not expect this behaviour again.

[REDACTED] asked if the Panel put her in care explained that it had been their decision but we were all worried that dad had not been able to care for them properly at that time. We spoke about the times when [REDACTED] played in the Wellgate Centre alone and the things they did while there. [REDACTED] also said daddy and [REDACTED] used to hit me hard but they do not anymore.

[REDACTED] also said that dad used to hit mum but he did not do this either now. Tried to explain that these were some of the things we were talking to mum and dad about but that [REDACTED] would be staying with [REDACTED] for a long time yet.
