Ms Archer and Mr Tarbett appeared happy and at ease. Had to ask him to leave to allow time for individual interview.

Discussed Ms Archer's relationships with men.
Ms Archer's relationship with Mr Tarbett past, present and future.

Ms Archer again said she found it difficult to continue any meaningful relationship with men. When she feels she is becoming close to someone she usually moves on.

Her relationship with Mr Tarbett in the past has been violent and abusive. Often these incidents were as a result of disagreements about care/discipline of children or Ms Archer's involvement with other men. Ms Archer finds it impossible to agree with Mr Tarbett's views on child care and behaviour management eg she would punish them by sending them to their bedroom then he would let them out, undermining her authority. She agreed he hit them on occasion.

Ms Archer and Mr Tarbett's relationship has not been violent since she returned this time but Ms Archer feels there is less pressure without the children.

Ms Archer returned because she thought they would get the children back immediately and she had nowhere else to go, the only accommodation available was bed and breakfast.

Ms Archer appreciates the effect their relationship has had on the children, especially the violence and continuing separations/reconciliations.

Ms Archer does not appear certain that her relationship with Mr Tarbett will continue.

Ms Archer feels access is going well, although she did comment that Mr Tarbett takes no part. She has asked him why he does not play with the kids but he told her he would not play with them at home so he will not play with them at access sessions.
