Significant Developments Since Last Hearing

- 1 Proof Hearings on 27 March and 3 April 1992. Grounds of referral established subject to minor amendments.
- 2 On 26 April Ms Archer was charged with Assault and Breach of the Peace following an incident in the Women's Aid Refuge where she was staying. This led to a brief voluntary admission to care for the three children while Ms Archer was detained in Police custody for a number of hours.
- 3 Ms Archer and the children are now living c/o a bed and breakfast address. Links have been made by Ms Archer and this Department with the Housing Department in the area and it is hoped that a tenancy will be offered to Ms Archer who is being treated as priority.
- 4 It is understood that at the Sheriff Court on 30 April 1992 Mr David Tarbett was awarded interim access of [REDACTED] and William for one hour per week. No official confirmation of this has yet been received by this Department. Any conditions are as yet unknown nor has the writer had the opportunity to discuss this with Ms Archer.
- 5 The close support system is still in place for Ms Archer and the children. Very regular attendance at the local Child & Family Centre is maintained by Ms Archer and the children.

The Family Centre have reported very favourably regarding the children's attendance and Ms Archer's participation in centre activities.

Conclusions And Recommendation

The recent changes in Ms Archer's circumstances is unfortunate and her behaviour which led to the changes as mentioned is in the writer's view out of character for her. However, the recommendation remains the same, that is, that all three children are placed under supervision in terms of Section 44(1)(a). It has been considered since the last supplementary report that a condition be written into the orders which states that the children be in the care of their mother.
