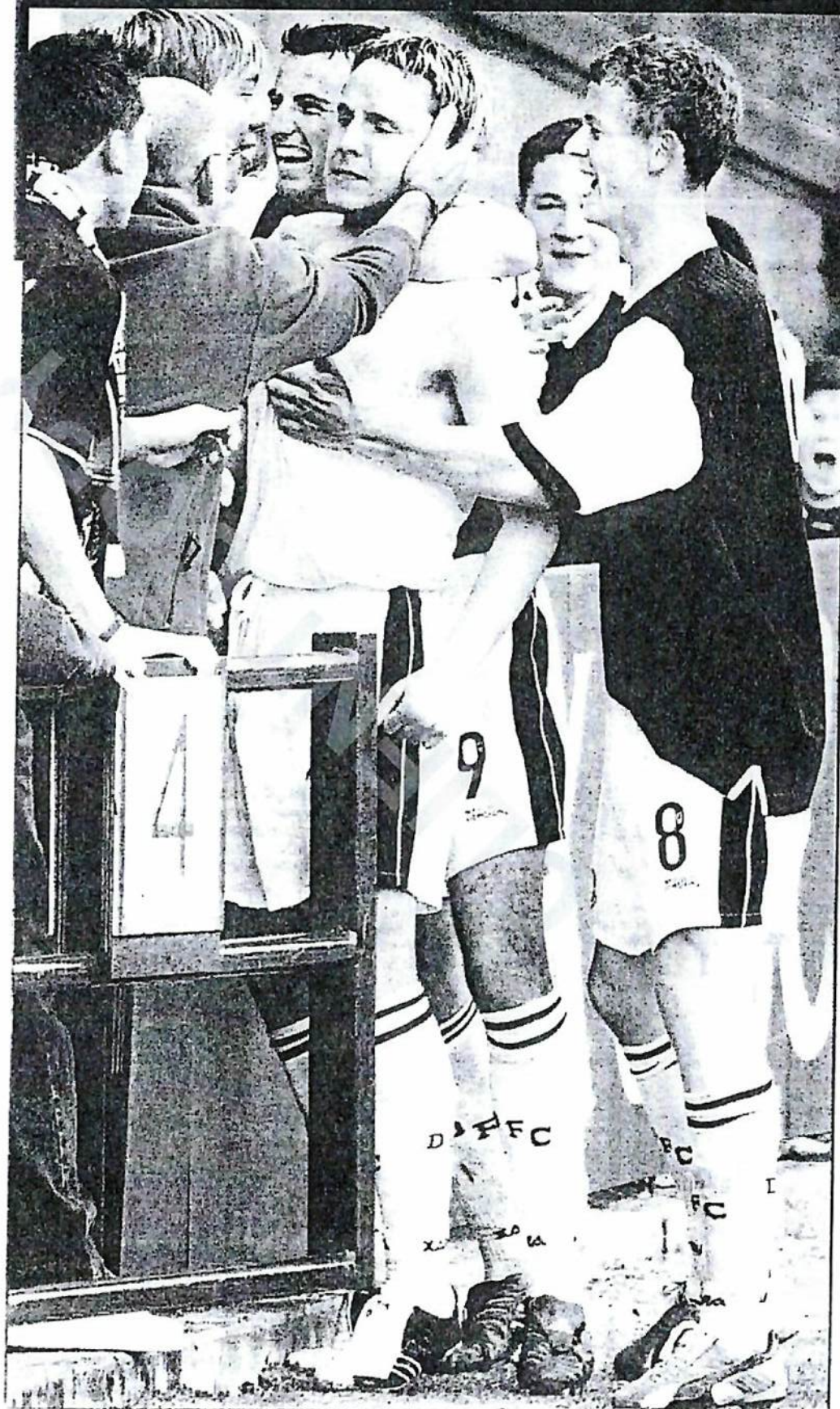

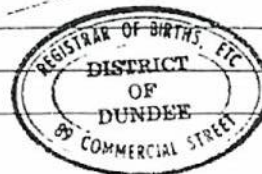

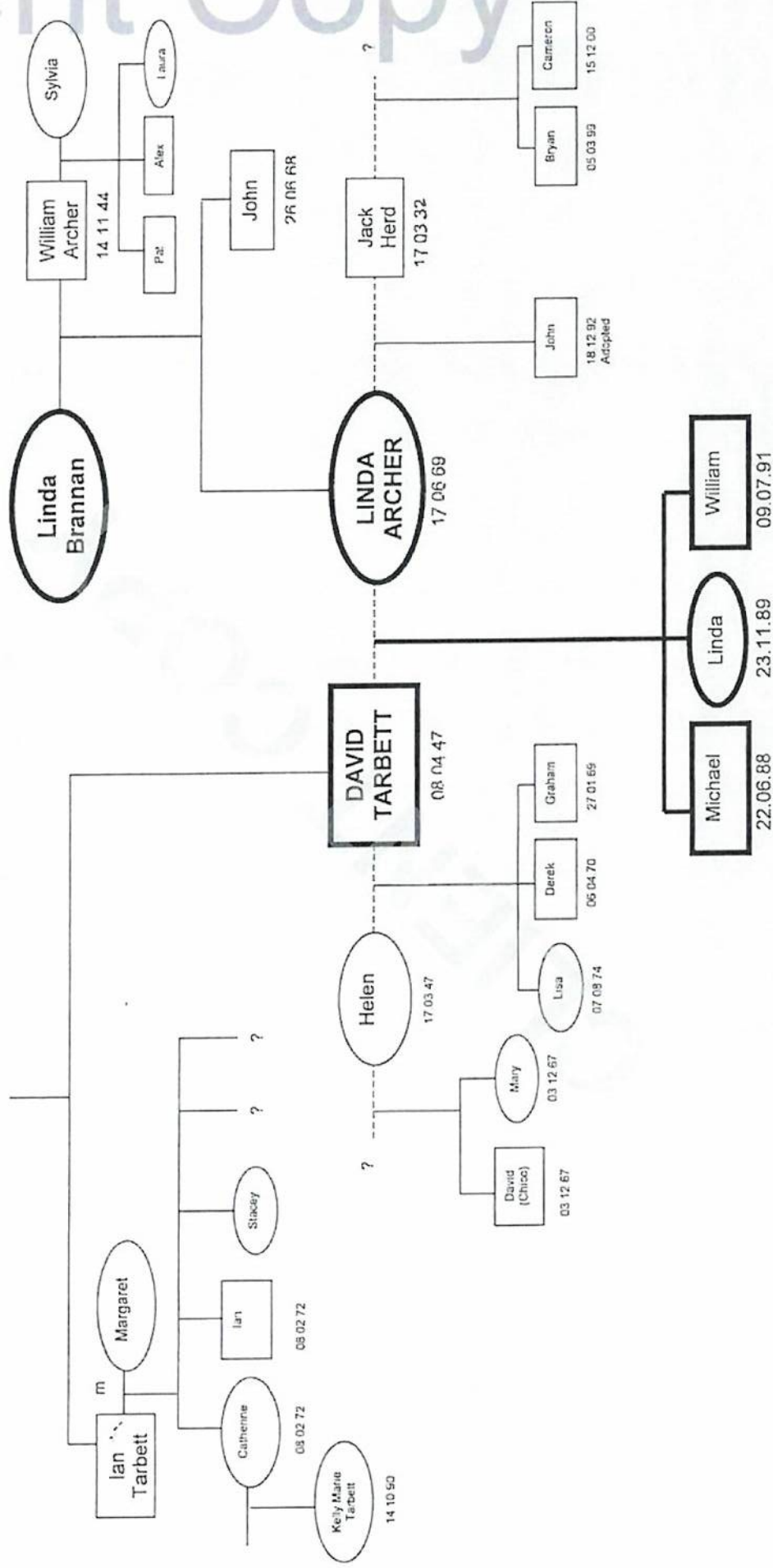

02.10.03 Telephone call from Jennifer at Strathcarron Young People's Unit	Mr Tarbett has been on the phone accusing staff of not feeding Billy properly.
06.10.03 - 07.10.03	Social Worker on annual leave.
07.10.03 Email from Strathcarron	Billy has been phoning his dad a lot on a mobile phone Mr Tarbett gave him in September.
17.10.03 Email from Brenda Kidd, Resource Worker for the Booths	Billy has been telling people in Auchterhouse that his mother has died.
20.10.03 Telephone call from Graham Webster, Strathcarron	Billy was involved in an argument with [REDACTED] father at the weekend. This developed further into a fight between Billy and [REDACTED] on Saturday but this has now helped to clear the air.

27.10.03 Telephone call to Liz at Strathcarron	William and the other boys at the unit have all given slight different versions of trouble with local youths. William does have 2 small nicks on his face and said he was trapped in Gowriehill School for a time. Liz feels that William has been much more confrontational lately and is being negatively affected by life at the Young People's Unit. Staff will try to clarify details in time for the LAC Review on 29th.
27.10.03 Telephone call to Mr Tarbett	Fed back above information and assured him that William did not require medical attention.
29.10.03 LAC Review	See minute.
10.11.03 Telephone call to Strathcarron Young People's Unit	Spoke to Donna re bank account for William. Agreed to send DLA form and birth certificate to them for purpose of opening bank account.
20.11.03 Meeting at Strathcarron	Meeting attended by Mr Tarbett, Graham Webster, Maureen Petrie, June Hopkins and Billy. See minute.
24.11.03 Telephone call to Mrs Ford, Monifieth High School	Left message confirming that I was aware of William receiving supports in class.
25.11.03 Email from Margaret Moyes	Email from manager in response to requests from myself and Bill Chalmers, Review Officer, to consider a family placement for Billy. Margaret Moyes assured that Billy continues to be considered for family placement.
28.11.03 Email from Strathcarron	Billy stayed at the [REDACTED] Auchterhouse, last night as today is school in-service day. Billy doing well inside and out of the Young People's Unit at present.

01.12.03 Telephone call to Strathcarron	Telephone line busy.
01.12.03 Telephone call to Brenda Rouse, DLA	Telephone line consistently busy.
02.12.03 Email from Strathcarron	Billy was at doctor's last night because of sore throat and was prescribed medication. Off school today but plans to return tomorrow.
03.12.03 Telephone call from Strathcarron	William has been unwell with a sore throat. He missed ice-skating because of this.
09.12.03 Telephone call to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] previous carer	Asked [REDACTED] re William's health book [REDACTED] said they never had this as William came to them before these were routinely issued. They have recently avoided Billy because of this disruptive behaviour.

19.12.03 Email to Margaret Moyes	Informed Margaret that Billy's behaviour has deteriorated recently and Choice are to become involved because of the number of recent offences. Notified her that Billy is still motivated re family placement. Response from Margaret Moyes was that Graham Oliver has refused permission for external referrals (to be reviewed in 3 months) so we need to continue to consider our own fostering resources.
29.12.03 Email from Strathcarron	Concerns raised that Billy has visited the home of [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] Staff concerned that [REDACTED] is not a safe associate for the young people at Strathcarron.
12.01.04 Telephone call from Graham at Strathcarron	Billy was the only young person in Strathcarron on Christmas Day but coped well with this. Billy has been having unlimited contact with his dad and has had a lot of cash and sweets/kebabs. Alongside this however he still speaks about having a family and has commented to staff that the only way to get one is to smash up the Young People's Unit.
	Billy also sees the more difficult youngsters getting trips with Choice Project and has said this is unfair. This may stop him being motivated to keep out of trouble. Graham Webster feels that he is generally becoming more aggressive towards staff.
13.01.04 Meeting with Margaret Moyes	Discussed my concerns re: 1 William being alone in Young People's Unit on Christmas Day 2 Family finding as William is still motivated 3 Increasing aggression so time is important for Billy 4 Contact - unlimited contact with dad but Margaret feels we should maintain formal contacts.
20.01.04 Telephone call to Strathcarron	Asked if contact could take place there with use of the snooker table. This is not something encouraged by the unit because of potential difficulties with birth families.
22.01.04 Telephone call to Elaine, Finance Department, Tayside House	Discussed Billy's bank account again and the only means of opening this is in joint names with myself - something which I do feel is appropriate.
22.01.04 Emailed Margaret Moyes	Requested further advice re bank account and voiced by reluctance to have my name jointly due to difficult birth family.

06.02.04. Telephone call from Paul, Strathcarron	Paul asking re family finding progress. Billy got detention at school on Monday for fighting with another boy but he was provoked when the other boy had said, "go fuck your mother". He had a better night last night.
07.02.04 Email from Strathcarron	Billy excluded from school - Friday 6th until Tuesday 9:00pm because of an assault on another pupil. Again teachers said he was provoked. Resolution meeting to take place on the 9th at 9:00am.
09.02.04 Telephone call from Strathcarron	██████████ came to collect Billy as he and Mr Tarbett were off to Perth Prison to visit their brother. Billy was not there as he had spent an overnight at the ██████████

This was fairly relaxed and it was agreed that Billy would visit ██████████ house later today or through the week.
19.12.04 Email from Graham Webster	Billy had mixed feelings after the meeting but did visit ██████████ this evening and met the other young person who lives with her. Other visits to be arranged with Strathcarron.
20.02.04 Telephone call to Doug Carrie, Reporter	Requested Review Hearing for Billy - report required by 1 March 2004.
20.02.04 Telephone call to Graham Webster	Billy in good form after his visit to ██████████

25.02.04 Telephone call to Strathcarron to confirm that Billy will go to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] house tonight	Billy wanting to go to [REDACTED] - in a very angry mood and not wanting to see her. Left it for tonight. Arranged to collect Billy from school on Friday to discuss future with him and key worker, Graham Webster.
25.02.04 Telephone call to [REDACTED] [REDACTED]	Informed [REDACTED] of the above. [REDACTED] very annoyed and stating that she will not be "messed about" by Billy.
26.02.04 Emails to and from Laura Gordon, [REDACTED] Resource Worker	Recognition of Billy's ambivalence about going to [REDACTED]. Agreed to monitor and support Billy and [REDACTED] through this. Also noted my concern at [REDACTED] lack of patience/understanding of Billy's ambivalent feelings about having a family placement.
27.02.04 Telephone call to Laura Gordon	Discussed Billy's current reluctance to go to [REDACTED]
27.02.04 Went to Monifieth High to collect Billy	No sign of Billy at the school.

27.02.04 Telephone call to Strathcarron	Informed Unit staff that Billy had not been at school - suspect he is avoiding me.
01.03.04 Telephone call from Strathcarron	Billy very agitated and unwilling to discuss [REDACTED]. Graham Webster had suggested going there for tea on Saturday but Billy left the Unit to go to Cupar with his dad (possibly to visit [REDACTED], his sister).
08.03.04 Telephone call to Paul at Strathcarron	Billy went missing at the weekend - went off with [REDACTED] from the Unit and appeared at Fairbairn Young People's Unit. There was an incident there but Billy managed to stay out of it - the other two were much more aggressive. Mr Tarbett had been informed, as had the police. Billy returned to Strathcarron at 12:15am and went up to bed and settled.
	Mr Tarbett came to the Unit after this and Billy heard him at the door but did not get up.
09.03.04 Telephone call from Strathcarron	Billy went to his dad's straight from school. When he came in at 7:15pm he was very arrogant.
10.03.04 Telephone call from Margaret Ford, Monifieth High	Billy's behaviour at school has been deteriorating daily - although much of this is bravado, Margaret is concerned that this will escalate. Arranged to pick up Billy from school next week.
15.03.04 Telephone call from Christa, Strathcarron	Billy has been nasty to staff. On Friday morning when there was no atmosphere or tension, he said to Donna, "Don't touch me - I could get you done for child molesting and you would lose your job". On Saturday morning he left the Unit at 9:00am and did not return until 4:30pm when he was in a foul mood. The Unit young people acquired alcohol and Billy ended up kicking his bedroom door and breaking the lock.
	He broke a window at the Unit on Sunday night. Christa said he is clearly having a lot of contact with dad and has seen a lot of [REDACTED] also.

16.03.04 Email from Strathcarron	Billy returned from school with £5 cash and chocolate bars. He left the Unit after tea with [REDACTED] but did not return on time and was reported missing to police. The three came in at 10:30pm by themselves and were drunk (lager, cider and vodka shots). Billy of to school this morning, but untidy and un-showered.
23.03.04 Telephone call to Disability Living Allowance	Billy currently receives middle rate Disability Living Allowance - care component and low rate for mobility - £727 per annum. Notified them of me being the new Social Worker.
25.03.04 Telephone call from Strathcarron	Billy has had contact with his sister, [REDACTED] and saw brother, [REDACTED] at Fairbairn Young People's Unit.
25.03.04 Telephone call to Linda Taylor, Finance	Queried management of Billy's back payment of Disability Living Allowance - I should complete F4 and she will hold Billy's money in an account as "client cash".
26.03.04 Email from Alan Hope, Choice Project	Alan is writing to the Reporter to get Billy exited from the Fast Track scheme, as there have been no offences since November 2003.
29.03.04 Telephone call from Graham Webster	Updated on Billy - still seeing a lot of dad and mum also around. Graham was at Baxter Park and bumped into the Tarbetts and [REDACTED] family. Linda Robertson was threatening to "slap" [REDACTED] Billy visited the [REDACTED] at Auchterhouse last Friday and is usually much nicer after visits to [REDACTED] family.
31.03.04 Telephone call from Margaret Ford, Monifieth High	Billy truanted on Monday afternoon - he left school at lunchtime saying he had a dental appointment but clearly the Young People's Unit had no knowledge of this. Billy may have ended up in Montrose but Margaret Ford will follow this up.
31.03.04 Telephone call to Graham Webster	Graham said that Billy is up everyday for school and away at 7:45am. However, [REDACTED] is having a negative influence on him in the Unit. Left note of my leave dates.

Mr Tarbett was annoyed with Billy - the Unit staff grounded him on Sunday night.

20.10.04 Discussion with Rosemary Crowe	Rosemary aware that Mr Tarbett had tried to entice Billy to the Forum Centre for a present so that he would miss his LAC Review. To his credit, Billy attended in spite of this.
20.10.04 Telephone call to Strathcarron	Informed staff of the above and fed back from LAC Review. Arranged to see Billy on 23 November - Maureen Petrie, Social Work Assistant, will try to arrange something on the November in-service days
25.10.04 Telephone call from Christa, Strathcarron	██████████ brought a gang from Fairbairn Street Young People's Unit to Strathcarron and ██████████ lured Billy outside where the gang of youths assaulted Billy. Billy's mouth was cut inside.
03.11.04 Telephone call from Donna, Strathcarron	Billy has been bullying a younger pupil to the point that the other youngster is afraid to come to school. This matter is being dealt with by school and Unit staff. Agreed to speak to Billy about this when I next see him.

SECTION 1

A meeting with young people was held on Wednesday 5 January 2005 to discuss various issues within the unit. It was agreed at this meeting that pocket money would be held back if young people had not cleaned their rooms before Friday, and that a quick "pick up" 5 minutes before pocket money was due, was not sufficient.

Gail had also advised ██████████ that they would not be given recreational money at night-time due to incident the previous week.

Following from this young people's meeting Gail spent time with ██████████ discussing her behaviour of late and asking what her reasons were behind this. ██████████ stated to Gail that she wants to stay here.

7 January 2005

4.00 pm ██████████, Billy and ██████████ arrived home from school within a few minutes of each other. Crista and Adele advised Billy and ██████████ that pocket money was not to be given out as agreed under the terms at the young people's meeting. Both boys not happy but were accepting of this. ██████████ very angry, leading to her kicking doors and heaters and being verbally abusive to staff. ██████████ saying that Gail had not discussed any of this with her. ██████████ then phoned her dad and other family members asking for money but to no avail.

Billy and ██████████ then joined in with ██████████ becoming abusive to staff. Doors etc continued to be kicked but boys were not involved in this.

4.45 pm – ██████████ made herself some tea as she did not want what staff were cooking. Boys then joined staff for tea and were pleasant and good company throughout, helping with clearing up etc. Staff again reinforced discussion from young people's meeting and how they had agreed to abide by this. After tea boys joined ██████████ company again and became abusive towards staff.

5.30 pm – ██████████ returned from school. Staff attempted to engage her in conversation on how her visit to the Doctor went and her outing for tea with ex-teacher went, but ██████████ was unresponsive and sought out ██████████ company. Staff did not have the opportunity to discuss pocket money etc with ██████████.

██████████ continued to be abusive towards staff in between making various phone calls, one of these to CRO. ██████████ demanded bus fares to go out and was advised that in her present frame of mind staff were not prepared to give her any money. ██████████ then shouting that we were denying her family contact. Crista tried to discuss this with ██████████ but she became more abusive.

As behaviour was becoming aggressive and threatening, pool balls were removed from games room as a safety precaution. On realising this ██████████ started screaming at staff to put them back and that she was going to "smack staff in the face with them". Her language was foul and aggressive throughout. ██████████ and the boys quickly joined in with this and were happy to do as ██████████ asked them.

██████████ then advised staff that this is their house and they should not have to put up with Crista (staff) as she stinks of body odour. Other young people joined in and were shouting that Crista should "try

washing herself". This continued over the course of the evening. Staff had several attempts at trying to speak to the young people and trying to separate the boys from the girls in order to pull them away from this, but to no avail. It was then decided that we would leave them alone in the hope that no response would lead to them becoming bored of this behaviour. Books and games etc were thrown over living room floor. When staff asked who had done this further abuse followed.

Staff then sat in room with young people to prevent further disruption or damage occurring. Young people chose to leave the room, complaining of the stink from Crista – this again initiated by [REDACTED]. Games room and living room locked off to prevent further disruption within them. Staff returned to office to give young people some time alone again. Young people upstairs and came back down with aerosols spraying them along staff hallway to "get rid of the smell" from Crista. When given no response to this [REDACTED] continued to scream threats towards staff, particularly Crista.

7.30 pm – Situation continued to escalate, cupboard door upstairs damaged due to [REDACTED] kicking it, doors walls being punched and verbal abuse towards staff continuing. Staff went upstairs and again tried engaging in conversation to de-escalate the situation. [REDACTED] became more aggressive and threatening, standing in a threatening manner just a foot from Crista's face. [REDACTED] was advised several times that this was unacceptable and that should she continue in this manner the Police would be called.

As situation continued to escalate with all young people, particularly [REDACTED] the Police were called. Leads to two CD players were removed from hallway as young people had been asked repeatedly to return CD players to room and that they should not be using them in hallway.

7.45 pm – Police arrived (PC Keley and Tindal, Lochee Office). They spoke at length with [REDACTED] re her behaviour but [REDACTED] continued to be cheeky in their presence. [REDACTED] was charged with Breach of the Peace which included kicking doors and heaters, and threatening violence towards staff. The Police then spoke to Billy, [REDACTED] together about their behaviour. [REDACTED] and Billy appeared to take on board what was being said, [REDACTED] continued to be rude and abusive.

8.45 pm – [REDACTED] asking other young people to go out and get "pissed" with her. All young people then left the unit.

9.45 pm – All young people returned. Staff asked them to head upstairs given the time and were advised that drinks would be brought upstairs when they were settled in their rooms. [REDACTED] was overhead saying that she was stoned, but when asked about this she denied it. Further threats and verbal abuse continued until night shift arrived.

10.00 pm – Ryan Rennie arrived at unit – ML, WT and AB in hall, all acting very silly.

10.15 pm – Ryan asked ML, WT, AB to head up to their rooms and get ready for bed. They informed Ryan that bedtime was not until 10.30 pm.

10.30 pm – ML, WT and AB sitting/lying on stair landing (at windows) cuddled into one another refusing to go to their rooms. Ryan explained to them that the only people they were themselves, as they may not get rec/activities next weekend if their behaviour continued. All young people sat on landing and pretended to fall asleep.

11.00 pm – AB, WT and ML went upstairs, sat in hallway. Young people lying in upstairs hallway, under their duvets covers pretending to be asleep. Young people asked to return to their rooms, young people refusing on the basis that "they are not getting rec money so why should they".

11.45 pm – DH returned to his room several times during this period but kept leaving and joining young people. All young people being abusive to Crista, despite being told not to do so on several occasions.

11.50 pm – All young people sitting in hall, language very sexualised, they kept throwing things at sleepover door.

12 midnight – NT, AB, and ML downstairs demanding to be given breakfast, as it was morning. Young people told breakfast was not until 8.00 am.

12.10 am – All young people back in upstairs hallway, demanding supper as they had not eaten all day and Ryan did not have the right to starve them. Ryan explained that as soon as they returned to their rooms and were all settled they would get a drink. Young people informed Ryan they would phone the Children's Rights Officer.

12.30 am – DH returned to his room and settled, WT, AB and ML still awake, being silly and abusive to Crista. Still demanding food/mediation and water.

1.00 am – AB, WT in their rooms. ML down at office demanding water/medication and herself, being abusive to Crista.

1.15 am – All young people settled in their rooms.
