Staff have been attempting to get Billy to look for work. Billy has been in contact with careers Scotland and is hoping to gain a placement on the Claverhouse training project.

SOCIAL WORK CONTACT

Billy's social worker is kept updated by email and phone and she has been in the unit to visit once this month. Billy is also working with Jill McKenzie his through care after care worker. Progress has been slow with this as Billy refuses to do any cooking for himself. Jill is working on this and hopes to get him more involved.

FAMILY CONTACT

Billy is continuing to have overnights with dad and he also goes with dad to visit his brother in Polmont. Mr Tarbett is very cooperative with staff and usually very helpful when staff have any concerns with Billy. Dad was also disappointed that Billy did not stick in at Henry Boot.

Billy is usually well behaved although staff do have to remind him about his language now and again. There was an incident however this month on 17 July, when Billy was very aggressive towards staff threatening to punch them if they did not return a DVD, which was an 18 copy. During this incident Billy left the unit and did not return until 2.30 am.

SOCIAL WORK CONTACT

Billy met with his Social Worker on one occasion this month and staff keep her updated by phone or email. Billy is also working with his Through Care After Care worker, Jill McKenzie.

FAMILY CONTACT

Billy is continuing to have overnights with dad and he also goes with dad to visit his brother in Polmant. Mr Tarbett is very cooperative with staff and usually very helpful when staff have any concerns with Billy.

EDUCATION

Billy has left school now and was offered a place on the Support Employment Scheme based at Dens Park, at first Billy was enthusiastic but he did not attend in the end.
