- William shall have contact with his father for not less than forty-five minutes, once per month; the contact shall be arranged and supervised by the Social Work Department.
- William shall have contact with his mother for not less than forty-five minutes, once per month; the contact shall be arranged and supervised by the Social Work Department.

The placement is meeting William's needs & for the past three years has been providing continuity & stability.

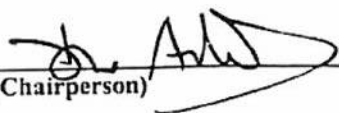
The last year has been difficult & this has been due to work with William on his history, as well as the introduction into his placement of another boy.

William is happy to stay with [REDACTED], & he has been making progress at school.

It is important to keep the contact arrangements as before, even though his mum has been inconsistent in coming to the agreed contacts.

WILLIAM TARBETT dob 09.07.91

William was placed with Mr and Mrs [REDACTED] foster carers, in March 2000 on a long term fostering basis. He made steady progress in placement, but the placement became increasingly fragile from the beginning of 2002. Following the placement of another child in July 2002 the placement deteriorated rapidly.

Attempts have been made to end the placement on a planned basis on April 5th 2000. However, the Social Work Department has been unable to identify a new long-term placement to date.

As the placement has drawn to a close it has become increasingly stressful for all parties. William has been involved in a number of violent incidents, culminating in an assault on Mr and Mrs [REDACTED] youngest child on Saturday 15th April. Mr and Mrs [REDACTED] requested his removal on that date, but later retracted this request.

An assessment of the situation on Monday 17th concluded William needed to be removed from the placement forthwith in order to prevent any recurrence of violent incidents prior to April 5th.

An emergency placement has been identified with Mr [REDACTED] ACE carer, until 11th April. William was moved to Mr [REDACTED] home on Wednesday 19th March.
