Thank you for your Subject Access Request regarding the records of Mr Brian Hunter.

I have searched all the surviving registers and records we have in the archive and found the following information. Mr Hunter was admitted to Nazareth House Kilmarnock on **22/11/1972**. He then left on **23/12/1977** when he returned to his father.
