Unfortunately her problems have returned and she still has overactive bladder problems which result in incontinence of urine and she has to use up to 5 pads in 24 hours. She did have cystodistension last year which helped her for a while but her symptoms have now returned.

I have placed her name on the list for cystoscopy and intravesical Botulinum Toxin A injection. She already knows of the possible complications and she is aware that it is still unlicensed for use in the bladder.
