The above referred patient was reviewed in clinic today how unfortunately continues to have her radial nerve deficiency in the form of wrist drop on the right side which is her dominant hand. The patient seems to have had the electrophysiology test and was told there was 40% damage to the nerve.

At this point she is not able to go back to work and continues to have the power in the extensors of the wrist which on examination today was less than 2.

Today I have advised her to persevere with the exercises and have arranged for her to be reviewed by Mr Ahmed only in the next few weeks to see whether it is worth considering referral to the peripheral nerve injuries unit which the patient will discuss with Mr Ahmed.
