Background: - Fracture Right humerus 04/05/2009.

IM nailing done 11/05/2009.

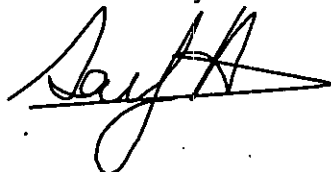
Non union.

Plating and bone grafting complicated by arm radial nerve
injury 18/06/2010.

Management: - Seen with results of nerve conduction studies.

This lady is one year and one month following her plating and bone grafting. The fracture has united. Her nerve function is gradually recovering. 2 months ago, according to the physiotherapist she had no hand function, but today there is appreciable wrist and finger extension and flexion. Nerve conduction suggests that there is evidence of re-innervation, and that only the radial nerve was affected, despite there being symptoms more globally.
