Diagnosis: Fracture right humerus 04 May 2009 treated with intramedullary nail
on 11 May 2009.
Non-union.
Plating and bone grafting for non-union 18 June 2010.
Post operative radial nerve neuropraxia.

I reviewed this lady in our clinic today who still has not noticed any improvement in her right wrist power. She still has altered sensations all around her forearm and fingers. Clinically she has altered sensations around C5/6/7 and C8 dermatome. Clinically her wrist extension was 1 out of 5. Also movement at metacarpophalangeal joint extension was absent. According to her she has been managing to extend her wrist from time to time which, clinically suggests that the nerve is working however, I am not sure if she has a CRPS.

I have referred her to the neurophysiology department for nerve conduction studies and I have advised her to do passive stretching of her wrist and fingers which she is doing herself. We will see her again once the nerve conduction study has been done.
