Diagnosis: Non-union right humerus.

Treatment: Fractured humerus treated by IM nailing, went into non-union.
Removal of nail and application of bone graft and plate fixation humerus,
complicated by radial nerve injury on 18 June 2010.

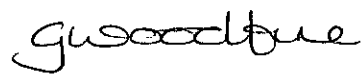
Mrs Margery has not noticed any improvement in her right arm pain. However, her wrist movement has improved according to her.

On clinical examination today she has Grade 3 power of dorsiflexion of her right wrist.

Check x-ray taken today did not show any further radiological signs of callous. However, it was difficult to appreciate.

Mrs Margery smokes roughly 10 cigarettes a day and she is aware of the fact that healing is a bit slower in somebody who smokes cigarettes. We have made an appointment to see her again in 2 months' time in our clinic with a new x-ray of her right humerus, AP and lateral view, on arrival.
