Katrina Margery attended the Sheppey MIU on the 30 Oct 2015.

The complaint was recorded on arrival as follows: Hand Problem (Left)**Referred By:** Self-Referred.**The History of the complaint was as follows:** Yesterday slipped on a manhole cover, put left hand, out immediate and continued pain. No analgesia taken. Right handed. No ice applied. Has had previous surgery to left hand, including metalware which has been removed.**Examination:**

1. Left Hand **Notes:** Walked in, looks well. Alert, orientated, calm. GCS 15. Holding hand in the air to prevent pain. Left hand:- held in flexion at the MCPJs. No obvious deformity. bruised and swollen over the dorsal and palmar little and ring finger MCPJs. Patient reports normal sensation to all fingers except little finger, which she cannot feel anything distally to the MCPJ. No wounds. No pain to palpate ASB. Movement severely restricted due to pain, unable to test tendon responses at this time due to pain. Analgesia given, XR hand requested.

The following radiology were done:

1. X-Ray **Site:** Hand **Side:** Left **Outcome:** Abnormal **Comments:** intra-articular fracture base little finger proximal phalanx

The Diagnosis was recorded as follows:

1. Intra-articular fracture, **Site:** Little Finger **Side:** Left **Comments:** from fall

The following treatment was given:

1. Verbal Guidance ; Discussed with Dr Javed, ortho SHO midway, to be seen by him in A+E. Advised of total loss of sensation. Patient will ask her neighbour to take her.

Drugs (Medication):

1. **Drug:** Paracetamol, **Route:** Oral, **Form:** Tablet, **Dose:** 1000, **Unit:** Milligrams, **Frequency:** Stat, **Batch Numbers/Expiry Date:** 20016 02/2020 crescent pharma

2. **Drug:** Ibuprofen, **Route:** Oral, **Form:** Tablet, **Dose:** 400, **Unit:** Milligrams, **Frequency:** Stat, **Batch Numbers/Expiry Date:** XP10319 03/17 Care+, **Comments:** patient reports that she is able to take ibuprofen without detriment to her asthma.
