Diagnosis: Fracture right humerus.

Background: IM nailing 2009, revision for non union to a plating in 2010. Post op radial nerve palsy, recovering.

Management: Conservative.

This lady is now 3 years down the line following her revision humeral fixation with a plate. Although Mrs Margery has still got significant stiffness and reduced function, motor function continues to improve even this far down the line following surgery. She has some weakness, but full extension of the wrist and fingers is possible. The pain appears more mechanical now. There are specific mechanical triggers that cause her discomfort. In addition she has also notice spasms in her arm and the hand seems to seize up after writing a few words. There is numbness at the back of the hand still.
