Diagnosis: - Fracture right humerus.
Background: - IM nail 11/05/2009, non union, plating on 18/06/2010, post op radial nerve injury, fracture now united
Previous Right shoulder surgery, sub-acromial decompression
Smoker 5-10 per day, not diabetic, Asthma
Date of Initial Injury: 04/05/2009.
Management: - Observation.

Mrs Margery's nerve conduction report one year ago suggested recovering partial radial nerve injury. There is no involvement of the other nerves. The brachioradialis and supinator are fully innervated, and the ECRL only mildly denervated. The EDC denervation had been more significant. This is in contrast with the function that she has at present, which is very little extension of the wrist and global sensory deficit in the hand. She is continuing to do her own exercises and function is probably improving.

She has been referred for a DEXA scan by her GP. I thought about referral for repeat Neurophysiological testing, but it is difficult to see what more can be achieved.
