49 Sheppey Beach Villas, Manor Way, Leysdown, Sheerness, Kent**Diagnosis:** Mid shaft fracture of right humerus treated with iron nail fixation
Fasciotomy of right arm on 11 May 2009

I reviewed this pleasant lady today, who has not been seen for the last 2½ months since the above procedure. She was apparently waiting for an appointment to be posted to her.

On examination today she is very sore and stiff. She has a very limited range of movement of the shoulder. Flexion of the elbow is from 0-110°, with painful pronation and supination, but no neurovascular deficit. The scar is well healed. Check radiographs show good alignment of the prosthesis, but no callous as yet.

I have also seen a letter from the Physiotherapy Department saying she is reluctant to take any painkillers, which would help with her movement. I have advised her to continue mobilising under the cover of painkillers to ensure optimum movement and regain her strength and mobility.

We will see her again in four weeks time, with x-ray on arrival.
