Displaced fracture, **Site:** Humerus **Side:** Right

Notes: Walked into unit with a neighbour. A 22 stone man fell onto patient while she and 2 others were trying to carry him home. Patient was sent to xray from DMC mobile unit. Xray shows displaced fracture of right humerus. Restricted range of movement present. Tingling sensation to from upper arm to tips of fingers and thumb. Reduced sensation to fingers and thumb. Circulation intact. Patient referred to Orthopaedic Registrar. Ms Reichert who advised for patient to be sent in to A/E for the attention of Orthopaedic SHO on call. Patient to be placed in a plaster cast for comfort. Patient has now agreed to have plaster applied.
