Diagnosis: previous venous thromboembolism

I saw this lady again today. I understand that her IVF was not successful and that she has now discontinued her Enoxaparin injections.

You will recall that she had significant bilateral femoral venous thrombosis about fifteen years ago but it turns out that her thrombophilia screen is entirely normal and a major predisposition to that original event must have been therefore the contraceptive pill that she was taking.

From a practical point of view whilst on a day to day basis she does not require any therapy she should require prophylactic low molecular weight heparin to cover any major surgery, following any significant trauma or during any prolonged immobility. I would wish for HRT to be avoided if at all possible.
