I have now seen this lady who had significant bilateral femoral venous thrombi fifteen years ago whilst on the contraceptive pill. Apart from this, she has been well in her life. She has never been pregnant.

There is a very significant family history in that both her mother and sister died at a young age, apparently of cerebro vascular accidents. A further sister is said to have had some form of thrombotic event.

Because I am concerned about the significant previous and family history in this case, I have asked her to increase her Clexane injections to 40 mg daily whilst I am investigating her prothrombotic tendency.
