This lady's shoulder pain is improving slowly, she is able to flex to 90degrees, abducts to 90degrees and has some internal rotation. She feels overall the procedure has helped her. On discussion with Mr Borowsky we have advised to continue with her exercises as much as possible and we will review again in 6 weeks. If she continues to improve at this point we can think about discharging her.
