Diagnosis: ? Chronic regional pain syndrome.

This lady has been having severe pain in both her knees which is also restricting her movements in walking. The pain is out of proportion to any anatomical abnormality which we could see.

On clinical testing her range of movement is restricted from 5-20°, and beyond that she has pain everywhere.

MRI scan done did not show any major meniscal damage but there was mild degeneration of the patellar articular cartilage.

Her pain is bilateral and I wonder if she is developing osteodystrophy. I have referred her for a radio-isotope bone scan and also referred her for local physiotherapy for mobilisation and local treatment. I hope this helps her and we will review her after the scan is done. She might need referral to a pain specialist if we do not find any major problem with the bone scan.
