49 Sheppey Beach Villas, Manor Way, Leysdown on Sea**

I would be grateful if I could have your expert opinion on the above named patient.

She was under Mr Deep for right knee problems which seem to have settled after an arthroscopy. Her main problem and cause of concern now is her right shoulder.

On examination she has a limited abduction to 45 degrees and the 45 to 90 degree arch is painful. Flexion is about 90 degrees. There is no tenderness over the AC joint, Scarfe test is negative.

I injected her sub acromial space when she was in the clinic last time with a mixture of Kenalog and Lignocaine. This relieved the symptoms completely but only for one week. She has also undergone a course of physiotherapy for her shoulder but this did not make any improvement.

I was wondering whether she may be a candidate for sub acromial decompression and would appreciate your taking over her care.
