Accompanied by partner [REDACTED], who provided some of the information. Referred for deterioration in depression and looking for talking therapies. Long-term depression normally treated with ADM from GP, however symptoms worsened since December. Presented today initially uncommunicative and difficult to establish rapport. [REDACTED] reported he has been staying in his bed for past 6 months, and only comes out if he has an appt to attend, and only accompanied by her. He described having no will to do anything, lying in his bed, with thoughts of being no good to anyone (his family). He has a background of being in care from age of 3 weeks. He did not initially know his mother, and then when he did get to know her they did not get on. She has been diagnosed with cancer in January, and this appears to be one of triggers to deterioration in mood. He does not sleep, appetite is poor, does not interact with the family, isolates self from them, and reacts angrily to noise in the house. Shouts at [REDACTED] and the children to be quiet. Lost interest in friends, and previous interests. They both describe this current presentation as not normal for him, and that his depression seems much worse. He had no idea of the what the appt today would entail and struggled to identify his feelings/thoughts. Became tearful when talking about [REDACTED] and his family, and distressed and confused as to why he reacts to them the way he is doing just now. He previously had thoughts of suicide ("years ago"), and denies any such thoughts today, saying he would be scared to do anything, as he would not want to lose, or ruin his family. Presentation: Casually dressed: thin (weight loss), tired and tense looking: subjectively "I am no good", "don't know how I feel" and could not rate mood, or complete CORE as did not appear to be able to focus on this. Sat in silence for most of the screening, and spoke quietly in short abrupt answers, eye contact poor, emotionally distressed at times, very poor at answering questions. Denied auditory hallucination, and no evidence of delusional thought content. Concentration

	poor. Denies alcohol or illicit drugs. Prescribed Fluoxetine which was increased to 40mg in March, with no subjective improvement. I have advised that I will discuss him with AMHT colleagues.
