I reviewed Mr Keown at our Physiotherapy Led Hand Trauma Clinic today. This left handed gentleman sustained a dog bite to his right little finger on 24.06.07.

Surgical Details

He attended Glasgow Royal Infirmary, A & E on 24.06.07. Mr Keown was taken to theatre on 26.06.07 for exploration of his right little finger. There was found to be no structural damage and his wound was washed out and sutured.

Rehabilitation Details

Today at clinic Mr Keown's wound was healing very well. The nursing staff removed every second suture today and the remaining stitches will be removed by Mr Keown's partner at their request as she is a trained nurse. Mr Keown's partner is also happy to re-dress his right little finger with inadine as advised by the nursing staff here. We have given dressings away today to continue with. He was also advised on an active range of movement exercise programme to continue with to regain his full movement. He demonstrated almost full movement today and we will follow him up at our Hand Trauma Unit to monitor his progress and ensure his recovery. We will inform you of any changes and/or final discharge.

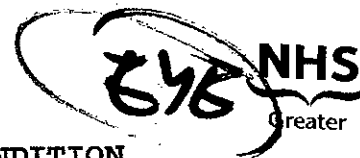

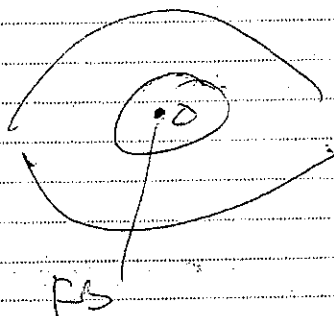
