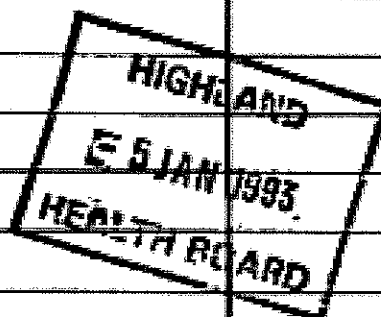

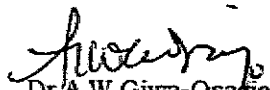

I saw this lady at Dr Milne's ante-natal clinic on 21.5.2001 at 36 weeks gestation. She was well and had no complaints. Urinalysis was normal, the uterine size corresponded to 34 weeks gestation, she had a singleton foetus in cephalic presentation and foetal heart sounds were normal. Ultrasound scan findings today were satisfactory with BPD and abdominal circumference just below the 50th centile while the head circumference remains between the 50th and 3rd centiles. Liquor volume was satisfactory. Her CTG trace was reactive. I have reassured her with regard to these findings but she is unsure about the events of her last pregnancy and would like to have an early induction of labour if possible. I have advised that she keep her previous appointment for the ante-natal clinic for next week to see Dr Milne for further discussions re the date of induction of labour.

This patient was admitted to Raigmore Hospital on 14.5.2001 having had some uterine contractions at 35 weeks gestation. Labour did not become established however and there was no evidence of cervical dilatation. Foetal heart traces suggested foetal wellbeing, which was obviously important considering her previous history and she was able to go home from hospital on 16.5.2001. She was unsure about the date of her last menstrual period but real time ultrasonography revealed the foetal size to be compatible with 14 weeks amenorrhoea, suggesting an expected date of delivery of around 18.6.2001.

Her first pregnancy seems to have been fairly straightforward but in her second, intra-uterine death occurred approaching 37 weeks gestation and she thereafter delivered a stillborn baby weighing 2.52kgs. No obvious cause was found but she was taking Inderal during that pregnancy and it is reputed to cause foetal growth restriction. I had forgotten about this when I saw her at my clinic this time but I would like to assume that she is not taking this drug now. I would be grateful if you could let me know this. She is taking low dose Aspirin which could be beneficial and she has been encouraged to stop smoking. Further encouragement may however be required.

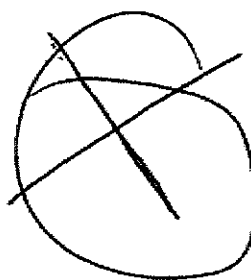

This patient was seen again at my gynaecology clinic on 25.5.2000 when the outcome of her recent pregnancy was discussed. She is recovering mentally but understandably slowly.

The post-mortem report on the baby has not yet been received but a verbal communication from the pathologist has told me that there were no obvious abnormalities in the baby. There was evidence however that the placental function was sub-optimal. Other tests carried out revealed no evidence of any viral, Chlamydial or toxoplasmosis infections and there was no evidence of lupus or antiphospholipid syndrome. There was no evidence of diabetes and her thyroid function is also probably normal. Cells from the foetus unfortunately did not culture but I think a chromosomal abnormality is unlikely. Cells from her partner revealed no chromosomal abnormalities. The cells from Miss Golabek herself also did not culture but a repeat specimen has been taken and I shall write again when that report is at hand.

It would seem therefore that sub-optimal placental function was the most likely cause of the foetal demise, although the baby was not grossly underweight when born approaching 37 weeks gestation (2.52kgs). Placental function may of course have been compromised by her smoking and by her taking Inderal throughout her pregnancy. I did not want her to feel guilty about this but she has quite a good insight into the problem and has said that although she does want another pregnancy sometime, she would like to have stopped smoking and stopped taking Inderal by that time. Although also there is limited evidence, it might be worthwhile her taking low dose Aspirin during any future pregnancy.

This patient was admitted to Raigmore Hospital on 21.04.2000 approaching 37 weeks gestation but having felt no foetal movements for the previous 2 days. Intrauterine death was diagnosed and labour was induced the following day. After 5 hours she had a spontaneous vertex delivery of a still born male infant weighing 2.52kg. No obvious foetal abnormalities were noted but a postmortem examination is being undertaken. The placenta weighed 475gm and was described by the midwife "pale and unhealthy". The notes also record "possible retroplacental clot" but I find this very difficult to understand as there either was or wasn't a retroplacental clot. I shall investigate this further. Other viral tests etc are being undertaken and I shall write again following receipt of these reports and of course the postmortem report.

Her main concern ^{was} the effect of her taking Inderal during her pregnancy. This as reported earlier, is reputed to cause foetal growth restriction and may well have been a major factor in the death here. It would be difficult to say this categorically however although in future pregnancies it perhaps would be wise for her not to take Inderal.

She will be seen for follow up at my Gynaecology Clinic on 25.05.2000 to discuss with her the result of investigations carried out and hopefully also to answer any questions she may have by that time.

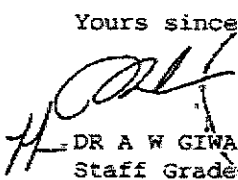

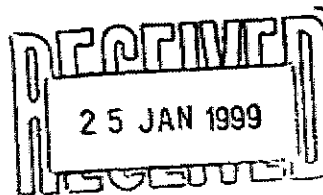
