Thank you for your letter regarding Amanda. Amanda is an 18 year old primigravida who presented today to Dr Herd's antenatal clinic. Her last menstrual period was early December and was quite a regular period. She is a smoker and smokes 10 cigarettes a day and has been advised to reduce the number of cigarettes that she smokes per day. She doesn't drink any alcohol and has been using suppositories for her constipation. Today she appears well although she is at the tail end of upper respiratory tract infection. Blood pressure was 110/70, and auscultation of the chest heart sounds pure and her lungs were clear. On transabdominal scan crown rump length found her to be 10 weeks and 6 days today making the estimated date of delivery to be the 15th September 1997. I did some booking bloods today. I have discussed screening but she wasn't sure whether she would be happy to have the test so she will think about it and attend yourself at 15 weeks gestation if she decides to go ahead with the test. 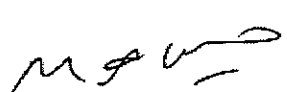

Amanda was admitted to our unit on 2. 4. 84 with a one day history of bleeding with defaecation associated with pain. She had had no preceding bowel symptoms. On examination at the time of her admission there was an anal spasm and she was difficult to examine. It was felt most likely the cause of her symptoms was an anal fissure and she was therefore taken to theatre that day with the presence of an anal fissure was confirmed on sigmoidoscopy with no evidence of any lesion higher up as the cause of her bleeding. An anal dilatation was therefore performed and she remained well following this and she was discharged home on Collogel and Dorbanex. I reviewed her again in the Registrar clinic on 30. 4. 84 and she remains very well with regular bowel action once a day on no continuing medication. She has no pain on defaecation, mother has noticed no P.R. bleeding. Examination was entirely unremarkable and I have therefore reassured her mother and discharged her from further attendance.
