I reviewed Mr Edgar in the cardiology clinic today. He is a 35 year old gentleman with a long standing history of atypical chest pain. He describes a sharp pain across the left side of his chest which is not always related to exertion. He has had this pain for several years. He is obviously worried because of his family history. I understand his dad had MI in his 50's and his half brother had MI in his 30's. He is a smoker, smokes 10 cigarettes a day. He is currently unemployed. He does not take much alcohol. He goes to the gym regularly and does power lifting. He sometimes gets chest pain during lifting.

On examination today heart sounds were normal and chest was clear. No peripheral oedema was noted. ECG showed normal sinus rhythm at 74bpm. There was no chest wall tenderness.

I reassured him that his chest discomfort is unlikely to be cardiac in origin. However given the family history and his ongoing symptoms I will arrange for an outpatient CT coronary angiogram to reassure him. If the CTCA is unremarkable I will not arrange further follow up.

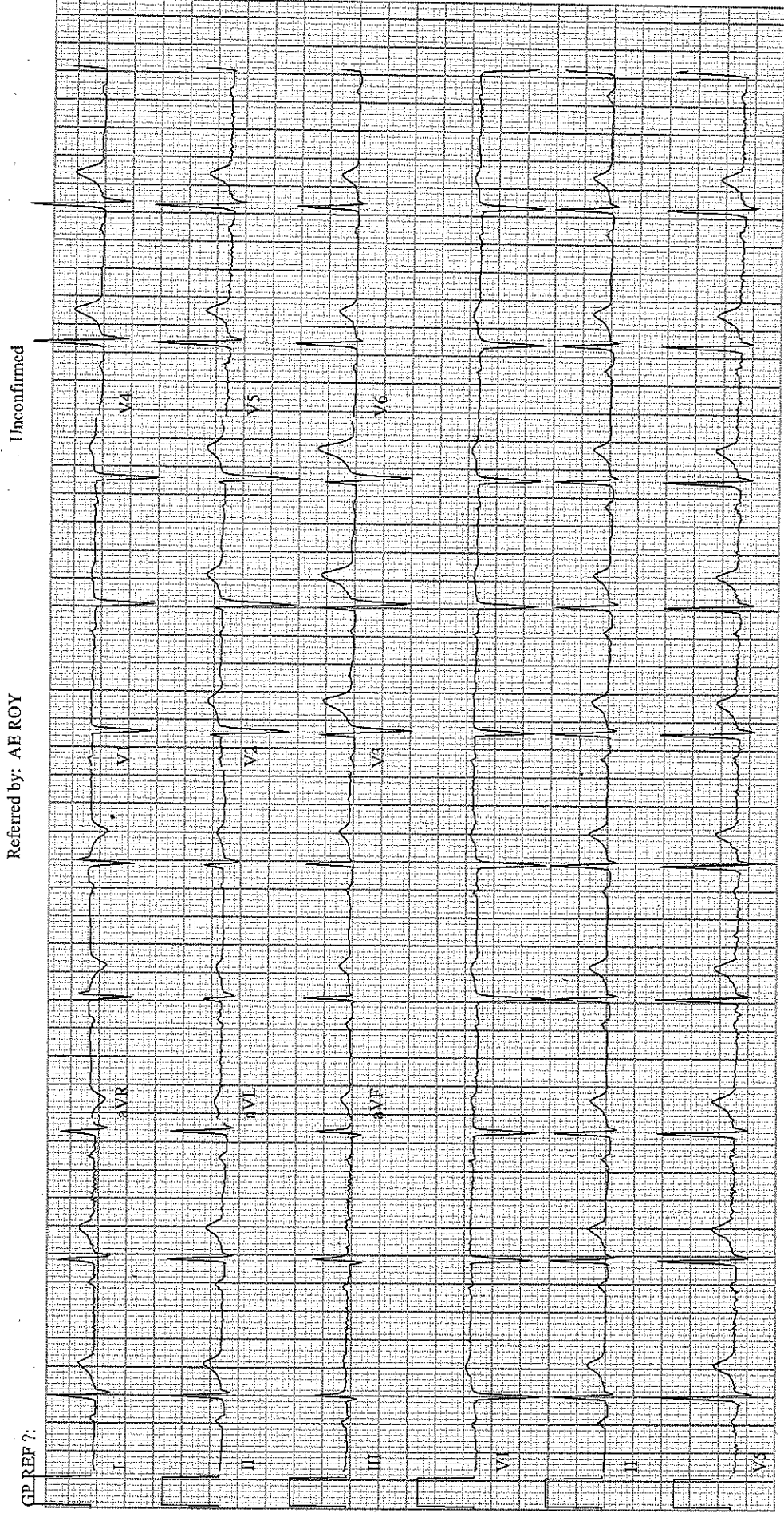

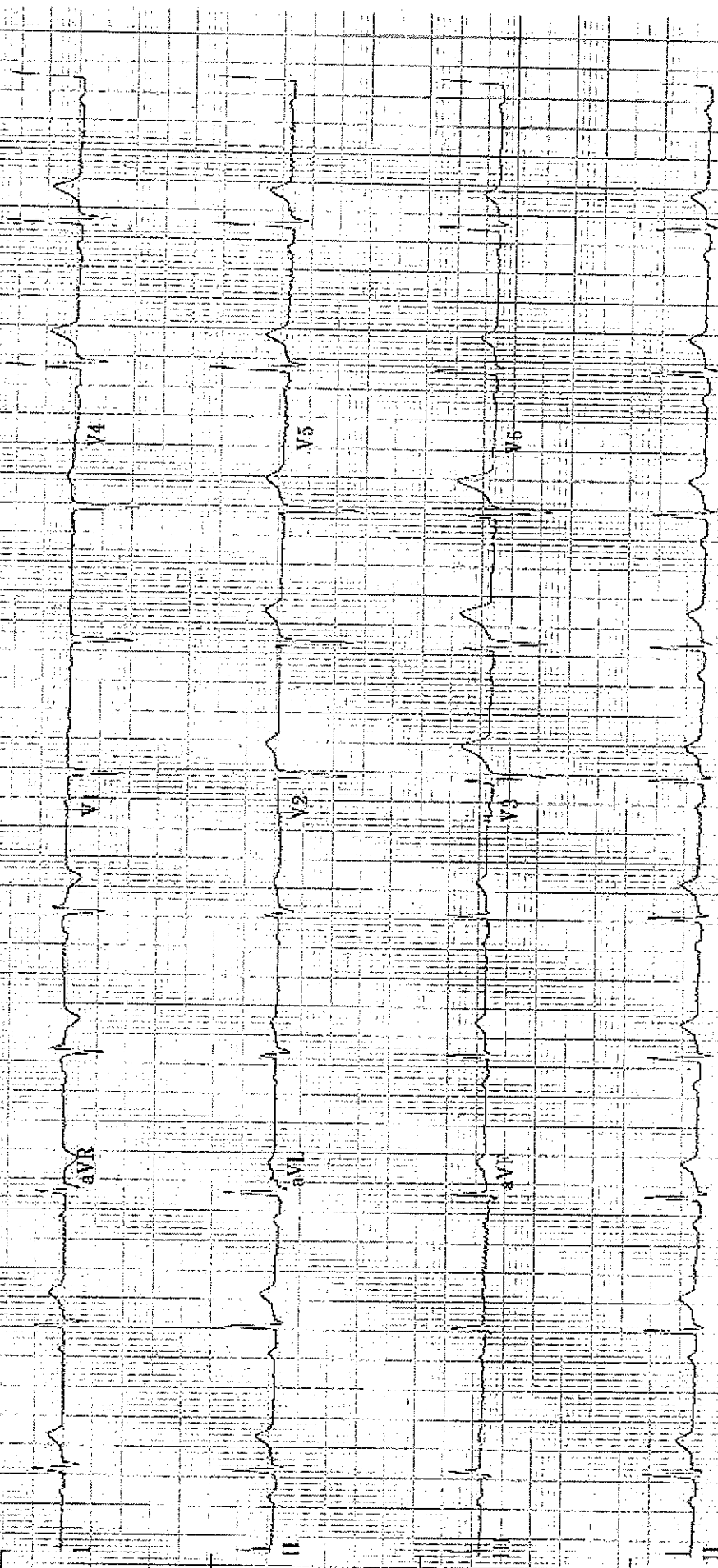
