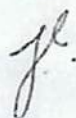

As it is envisaged that this will be a permanent arrangement, it has been decided to consider Mrs. Markie for fostering allowance, and appropriate action is being taken.

As interim approval has been given to this foster home, would you please arrange for fostering allowances to be paid to Mrs. Helen Markie commencing 30th July, 1979, pending full approval being given.
