Thank you for your request to exercise the right(s) of your client under the above Article(s), received on 5 June 2026.

Unfortunately, having considered the circumstances of your request the Council is exercising its powers in terms of Article 12(3) of the GDPR to extend the time period to respond to you.

Unfortunately, we will be unable to respond to your request by 4 July 2026, the reasons for doing so are as follows:

- **Complexity:** Due to the complexity and volume of data, we need to carefully review all records to ensure appropriate redactions to remove the personal data of third parties before it can be securely shared

We will endeavour to provide the information to you as soon as possible but no later than 2 September 2026 we will keep you updated and would like to thank you for your patience during this time.

Complaints

If you want to complain about the way we are handling your request, you can

Application to court

- take steps specified in the order or
- refrain from taking steps specified in the order.

You should take your own independent legal advice about going to court.
