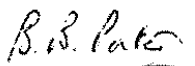

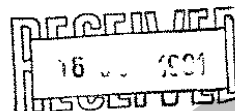

Thank you for referring Mr. Joyce following the chest x-ray report. Unfortunately this appears to have been misplaced by ourselves and I was unable to see the report today. He has a history that for the past six months he has been generally unwell, getting recurrent sharp pains across the front of his chest radiating to the inside of his arms lasting 1 - 2 hours and they were throbbing. They were not related to posture or exercise, but were aggravated by deep breathing or coughing. He has no relief with antacids. During the attacks he is sometimes short of breath. He gives no history of paroxysmal nocturnal dyspnoea, orthopnoea or palpitations. At the beginning of this upset he complained that for 4 weeks he had had blood stained sputum in the morning with clots of blood and this has not recurred since then. He is now short of breath on exertion and feeling tired after two flights of stairs and would now be unable to run for a bus. He also states that for six months after getting dressed and running out and up a few flights of stairs to catch his bus, he vomits but most mornings there is no blood in it and is not really preceded by a feeling of nausea. He complains of 2 sts. weight loss in 2 months.

Medical history: Stabbed in the left side of the chest 5 years ago. He has no serious past medical history and in particular no history of rheumatic fever or scarlet fever. He smokes 30 cigarettes /day and is not married. His mother died of a brain tumour aged 48 but his father is alive and well as are his 3 sisters and brother.

Occupation: Painter and decorator.

Alcohol: He used to drink heavily until 6 months ago but now drinks only a few pints a week.

Systemic enquiry: No other complaints.

On examination: There was no lymphadenopathy and no evidence of splinter haemorrhages and palpation of the thyroid was normal. He was not clinically anaemic, but had a sallow complexion. B.P. was 120/80 in both arms. There was no pulsus paradoxus, no radial femoral delay and the carotids were of good volume. J.V.P. and the apex beat was normal. Heart sounds were normal with a normal split second sound. During rest there was no added sounds but during exercises a short ejection systolic murmur was heard at the base. I could hear no evidence of any mitral valve disease. Examination of the abdomen, central nervous system and chest were normal and rectal examination was normal apart from a prolapsed pile. Examination of the fundi was normal.

Overall this was a normal clinical examination and we found nothing clinically that could substantiate any diagnosis of mitral valve disease. He does indeed look exceedingly well for somebody who has a history of haemoptysis and morning vomiting such that he has had and he certainly does not look as if he has lost weight.

I have checked out his chest x-ray and cardiograph and performed routine investigations and have also checked out his liver function and gamma G.T. just in case he is drinking more than he admits to.

I will see him again in the near future and will forward the results to you as soon as I have them. Thank you for referring this patient.

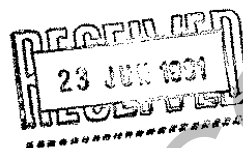

Mr. Joyce's results are back:-

Chest X-Ray shows no evidence of cardiomegaly and there is no convincing evidence of any pulmonary venous hypertension and the lung fields are clear.

His gamma G.T.P. is normal at 13 units/L.

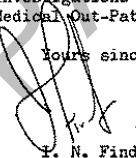
His biochemical profile - urea and electrolytes, liver function tests are normal.

His full blood count is normal apart from a simple neutrophilia at 14.6 but his haemoglobin is normal and there is nothing really to account for this simple neutrophilia and I would doubt if it is of any significance.

His E.C.G. shows sinus rhythm. There are small Q-waves in his inferior leads but these are not of a pathological significance.

I am afraid that our investigations have not turned up anything significant and he will be reviewed at Medical Out-Patients in due course.

You last saw the above 40 year old man at your Outpatient Clinic in June, 1981, after a chest x-ray was reported as showing ? pulmonary venous hypertension and a murmur was queried. His symptoms did not really fit in, however, and there was little objective to find. Your registrar at the time, Dr I Findlay, saw him on two occasions but the patient recalls seeing you too. Investigations at that time were normal, including chest x-ray.

He has been attending myself with "iffy" back pain and was seen by the R.M.O. who noted a diastolic murmur at his second intercostal space. When I saw him, however, I thought I could only hear a split P2 but did wonder about a faint systolic murmur in inspiration. This did not sound dissimilar to Dr Findlay's findings in 1981.

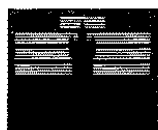

Recently, he has been taking Co-codamol rather than a non-steroidal.

On examination, his blood pressure at 120/80 and I confess that both my post-graduate and myself could not detect any murmur at all. His second sound splits but I think that this is a normal split. Chest was clear.

In the context of a normal ECG and completely normal cardiac findings on this occasion, I felt that I could reassure Mr Joyce. As he was complaining mainly of joint pains etc, I did CRP and some immunology. I shall let you know if this shows anything.

This 49 year old gentleman was admitted with chest pain. It was fairly atypical and particle relieved with ibuprofen and was tender on palpation. There were no other symptoms of note. I see from his case sheet that over twenty years ago he was seen by Dr McArthur for similar complaints of chest pain.

On examination pulse was 80 beats per minute and regular. Blood Pressure 117/8. Cardiovascular, respiratory and abdominal examinations were all normal, aside from tenderness over the anterior chest wall.

The impression was of musculoskeletal chest pain but his ECG showed some minor ST elevation anteriorly and he was therefore admitted for observation overnight. A Myocardial Infarction screen performed the following morning was negative and he was therefore allowed home. There are no plans for follow-up.

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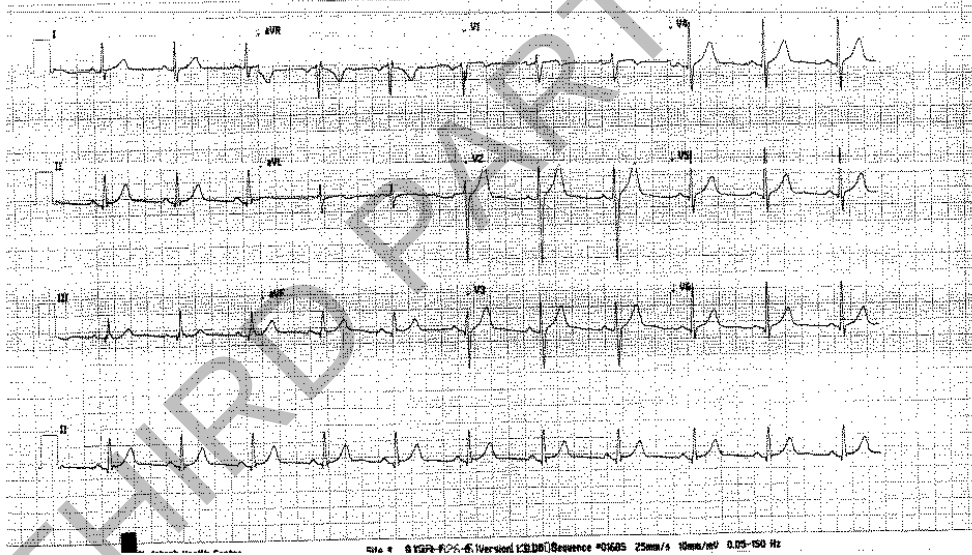

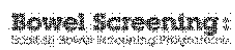

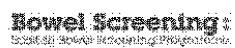

This patient 1305546016, DANIEL JOYCE, 165 FAIFLEY RD, CLYDEBANK, . . . G81 5BQ returned a bowel screening test kit. **The test was negative.**

This means that no faecal occult blood was detected and therefore no further investigations are required. Your patient will be called for screening every two years until they reach the age of 74.

Please note that the bowel screening test will not detect all colorectal cancers. This is because not all cancers or polyps bleed all of the time and the screening test is looking for blood. The screening test picks up two out of every three existing bowel cancers. Cancer can also develop between one screening test and the next, so it is important that your patient repeats the screening test every two years and never ignores symptoms.

Symptoms and signs of colorectal cancer:

- Persistent rectal bleeding without an obvious anal cause.
- Persistent change in bowel habit (> 6 weeks), especially to looser stools.
- Right sided abdominal mass.
- Palpable rectal mass.
- Unexplained iron deficiency anaemia.

These symptoms can be caused by a number of conditions including bowel cancer. If your patient makes you aware of these symptoms please note that it may be bowel cancer despite the negative screening test and consider making an urgent suspected cancer referral through SCI Gateway.

Cancer may occur as a result of a genetic predisposition particularly if the affected individual is young or there are several cases in the family. Referral guidelines have been developed for breast, ovarian and colorectal cancer. Where there is concern in asymptomatic patients, a detailed family history should be taken and patients should be referred to the Regional Cancer Genetics Unit for a comprehensive risk assessment and surveillance as appropriate.

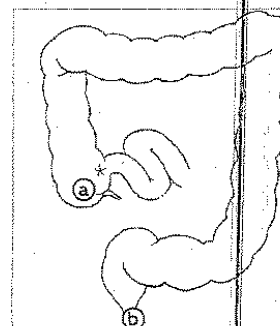
