Past ***** continues to play a part in his daily life - feels he has "demons" inside him at times, can experience visual ***** and finds himself having a conversation with someone inside his head who he does not recognise - this voice can be intrusive but is managing this element and it is not happening regularly, only when he is feeling overly stressed/anxious. Recent increase in mirtazapine to 30mg - been on this about 9 days. Aware that it is early stages. Increase supporting sleep slightly better but no improvement in the mood/anxiety issues. Encouraged to give it some time to reach therapeutic level. Discussed supports he is involved with - attends *****'s Man Club and also is engaged with Brotherhood in Arms. Positive reinforcement given. Looked at other resources to aid in building his coping strategies. Shared that he feels he does need further support to deal with past issues of *****. Discussed referral to psychology for ***** work - advised that the waiting period is extensive. Happy for referral to be done. Current anxiety +++, struggles to leave the house, racing thoughts, overthinking, unable to switch off. Mood elements - sleep can still be disturbed but not as bad as previously, poor motivation and interest in life at times but does try and push himself. Not working due to MH and physical issues. Appetite fair. Overall supportive conversation. P; Continue on 30mg mirtazapine. May require further increase to 45mg. Referral to secondary. MH and med review in 3.5 weeks. Appt issued.
