
I know that you recently attended surgery to see Dr Wooff. I have now had an official letter from Dr Lufty the Consultant Pathologist who deals with the cervical smears in Dumfries & Galloway and he wishes me to contact you about the urgency of having your cervical smear test carried out. The last smear you had in January of 1996 showed fairly major changes and it is important that these are followed up either by a further cervical smear test or by attending the local gynaecologist. I cannot emphasise too much the need for you to have a follow up smear although I know that you did have a colposcopy carried out and cold coagulation treatment to your cervix in 1996. However sometimes the problem can reoccur and it is very important that I carry out regular cervical smears to ensure that this does not happen. Please come along to surgery and I will carry out a smear test for you.


I saw this patient for colposcopy on 20th March. She had had moderate dyskaryosis on her smear taken in January.

✓ On examination there was a small area of CIN, this area was fully seen and not suspicious. The I.U.C.D. was removed, then cold coagulation was performed under local anaesthesia. The I.U.C.D. was not replaced at the patients request as she was going to try in the near future for a further pregnancy.

The Pathology report of the biopsy has confirmed the presence of CIN I/II.

We will see the patient for review in about 4 months.

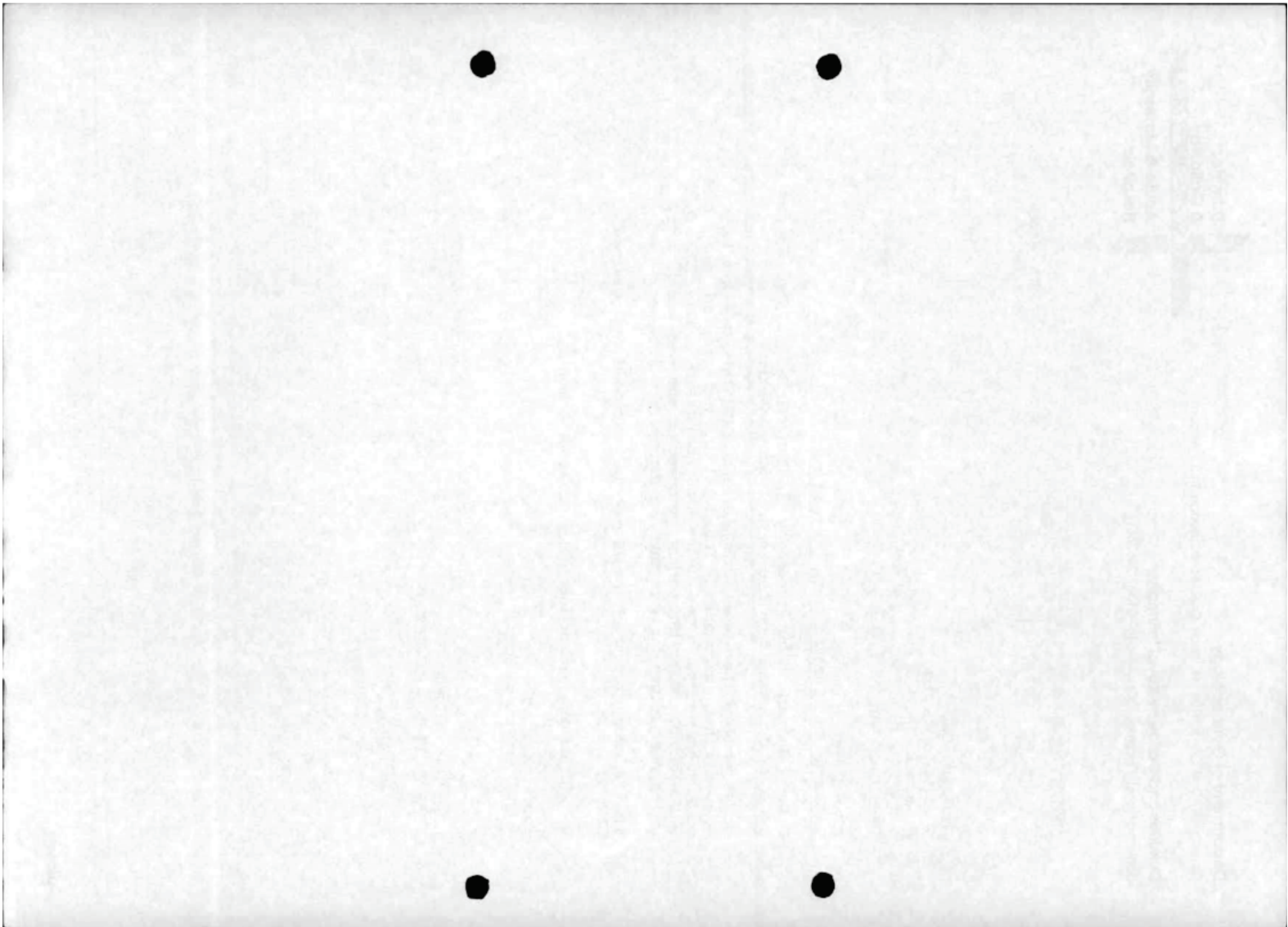


Thank you for referring this patient whom I saw today in the surgical clinic. She gives a history of occasional dyspepsia, epigastric discomfort radiating through to the back. No history of jaundice. She does however feel nauseated but never vomited. She tells me her bowels are regular, no urinary symptoms, periods are regular.

On examination of her abdomen I could find no abnormality but minimal tenderness in the epigastrium and right hypochondrium.

I saw this patient at the Dermatology Clinic on 9/11/94. She feels that so far treatment has not been particularly helpful so I have discussed at length with her her treatment options. I think a course of retinoid therapy might be appropriate in her case, but her initial reaction to the side-effects was very marked so I thought we should give her time to think that over. I therefore recommended an initial course of Erymax 250 mgs twice daily for three months and locally Panoxyl wash, Acnival wash and Isotrex gel. I have arranged to review Miss Holmes in ten weeks time when we can re-assess the situation and following reading the information leaflet regarding Roaccutane she may have reached some conclusion about her wish to have a course or not.
