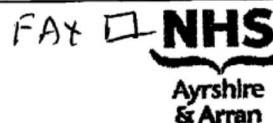

Thank you for your referral of the above 32 year old gentleman with previous history of assault (infra-orbital zygoma fracture and repaired in 1997) and currently on Methadone for his drug abuse history. Acuity 6/18 in the right, 6/9 in the left. Intra-ocular pressures normal. There is no relative afferent pupillary defect in either eye. Slit lamp examination showed normal anterior segment. There is no evidence of any enophthalmos. Fundal examination is healthy. In view of the inconsistency between his symptom and the findings I have asked him to come back for a visual field test. We will repeat the Ishihara color plate testing on the day of the visual field test as well.

Many thanks for referring this patient whom I saw on behalf of Mr Hislop. He presented complaining of blurred vision in the right eye which began 3 months after his original operation. Ringing in his right ear has been present about a year, pain in his top and bottom teeth have been present for about a year, headaches on the right side for about a year. He had a malar osteotomy on the right side in July 1997 and the teeth extracted in August 1998. He reports the pain in the teeth on the right side is like a dull ache. I understand that he attends a Psychiatrist regarding some form of mental health problem and that he had an endoscopy which revealed that he had some peptic ulceration. He had no asymmetry, enophthalmos or hypoglobus. He had free range of eye movement, however, his visual acuity was 6/18 in both eyes. He had no evidence of diplopia. He has paraesthesia of the right infraorbital nerve region. His occlusion is normal and I pulp tested all his teeth in the right side which are all normal. Radiographically he has plates related to his right malar osteotomy. He coincidentally has caries in the LL7.

Clinically he also had very poor oral hygiene as well as poor periodontal health. There is no sign of infection from the plates. I have advised him to see his dentist for a scale and polish and we have arranged to do a diagnostic nerve block with Bupivacaine in the right infraorbital nerve, in case some of his pain is due to hyperaesthesia following damage to the right infraorbital nerve. We will of course keep you informed of progress.

John was reviewed at the Bridge Project Cumnock on 4 August 1999. I understand he has recently transferred to your list (and moved house).

He currently is prescribed 120ml methadone, takes ½ -1 gram of heroin (used by inhalation, occasionally by injection – performed by others) daily and as much diazepam as he can.

Dr Lind's letter of 20 May 1999 makes it clear that diazepam is not helping John, yet he asks for this to save him taking more heroin. Again, he was unable to recognise the effect it has on him and refuses to consider reducing.

It is possible that his dual diagnosis appointment went astray as he has moved house. I will therefore ask for a further review by them. I feel my role is limited.

The above patient was reviewed in our clinic this morning following malar osteotomy to the right side approximately 4 months ago. John is still complaining of severe pain in the right side of his head and face and states that he is having to take regular Dihydrocodeine tablets for this.

He gives a strange history that he contacted your surgery for a repeat prescription of the analgesic and states that a female doctor he saw was rather brisk with him and he is alleging an assault took place in your surgery! I tend to feel that John is perhaps exaggerating the truth somewhat as on examination today he does appear to be slightly under the influence of narcotics.

We have advised him to try a different pain killer, but he states that she is unable to take anti-inflammatory analgesics, in view of the fact that he has a gastric ulcer and that various other pain killers he had tried have not worked. I tend to think that he is only attempting to gain a prescription for Dihydrocodeine from us and we are therefore reluctant to prescribe this.

He then complained of pain for his remaining teeth and requested that they all be extracted. An OPT X-ray was taken today and reveals caries in 3 or 4 of his teeth, but this in no way warrants a full dental clearance.

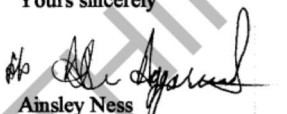

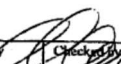

On examination he was undistressed and there was no cardiovascular or respiratory abnormality on examination. His abdomen was soft although there was marked tenderness in the epigastrium. Routine bloods plus amylase and LFTs were normal as was his full blood count. Chest x-ray and abdominal x-ray revealed no abnormality. The pain was slow to settle and in view of this an in-patient endoscopy was performed which was normal.

He was well enough to be discharged from our care on 20.10.97 with no follow-up planned.

Many thanks for your letter dated the 23rd October. As you say in your letter, this patient seems to have some reduced visual acuity in both eyes. If the visual acuity is decreased in one eye, on the side of trauma, it is more likely that this is caused by the trauma although it has been shown in research that the difficulty comes in that a lot of patients with trauma have decreased visual acuity prior to the assault, and this may be the reason that they get hit.

It is a possibility that his visual acuity was decreased because of the trauma, although I would suspect it was decreased prior to that.

I think if any medical legal action is being contemplated by your patient the I would suggest a referral to an ophthalmic consultant for a proper assessment of his fundi etc.

This 17 year old boy was admitted as an emergency to Ballochmyle on 17.9.85 with a four day history of abdominal pain, mainly in the right iliac fossa. We did not feel there was sufficient indication to warrant a laparotomy in his case and he was simply kept under observation for a few days. We ultimately allowed him home again on 23.9.85 with no definite diagnosis having been reached.

The straight x-rays showed quite marked loading of the colon and this may have been contributing to the problem. He remained apyrexial throughout his stay in hospital and there was no elevation of the white cell count. There was a slight persistent tenderness in the right iliac fossa but eventually we felt we could not justify keeping him in hospital any longer.

Microscopic examination of his urethral discharge showed numerous gram negative diplococci and a diagnosis of gonorrhoea was confirmed on culture. I saw John at The Bridge Project on 15 July 1992.

I think you know John and his family already. John is single and unemployed and is living with his parents in New Cumnock. He presented to The Bridge Project about a month ago asking for help with his drug problem. He told us that he uses Amphetamines every day. He injects this 2,3 or 4 times and says he goes through a variable amount averaging out at about 1 or 2 grams a day. He says that on the days that he cannot obtain the Amphetamines which is very infrequent he uses Temgesic or Temazepam.

He described himself as feeling depressed, fed up most of the time and craving for drug use. It has been some considerable time since John has gone for more than a day without any drugs. He told me as well that you prescribed Methadone for him for a short period last year, and he was indeed quite annoyed that this had been stopped.

John had been living with a girl in the past but he has split up from her, and sees neither her nor his 2 children, although he says that this is the way that he would want it to be.

On examination, John appeared very well. He told me that he only uses the same veins on the back of his left hand and has been using these for 18 months, but remarkably there

was not an injection mark to be seen. He was also unable to tell me what type of needles he used. John had come to the interview himself with a very clear idea that he wanted to go on Methadone. He had a very clear idea that this would help him and that this would stop him injecting. Things are obviously rather difficult in the absence of any injection marks and other aspects of his history would cast considerable doubt over John's account of his drug use. It would clearly not be very helpful to add another addictive drug to his habit, and I did my best to explain this to John, but I do not know how much success I had. He did agree to continue talking to Sally however, and I will keep an eye on how things progress.
