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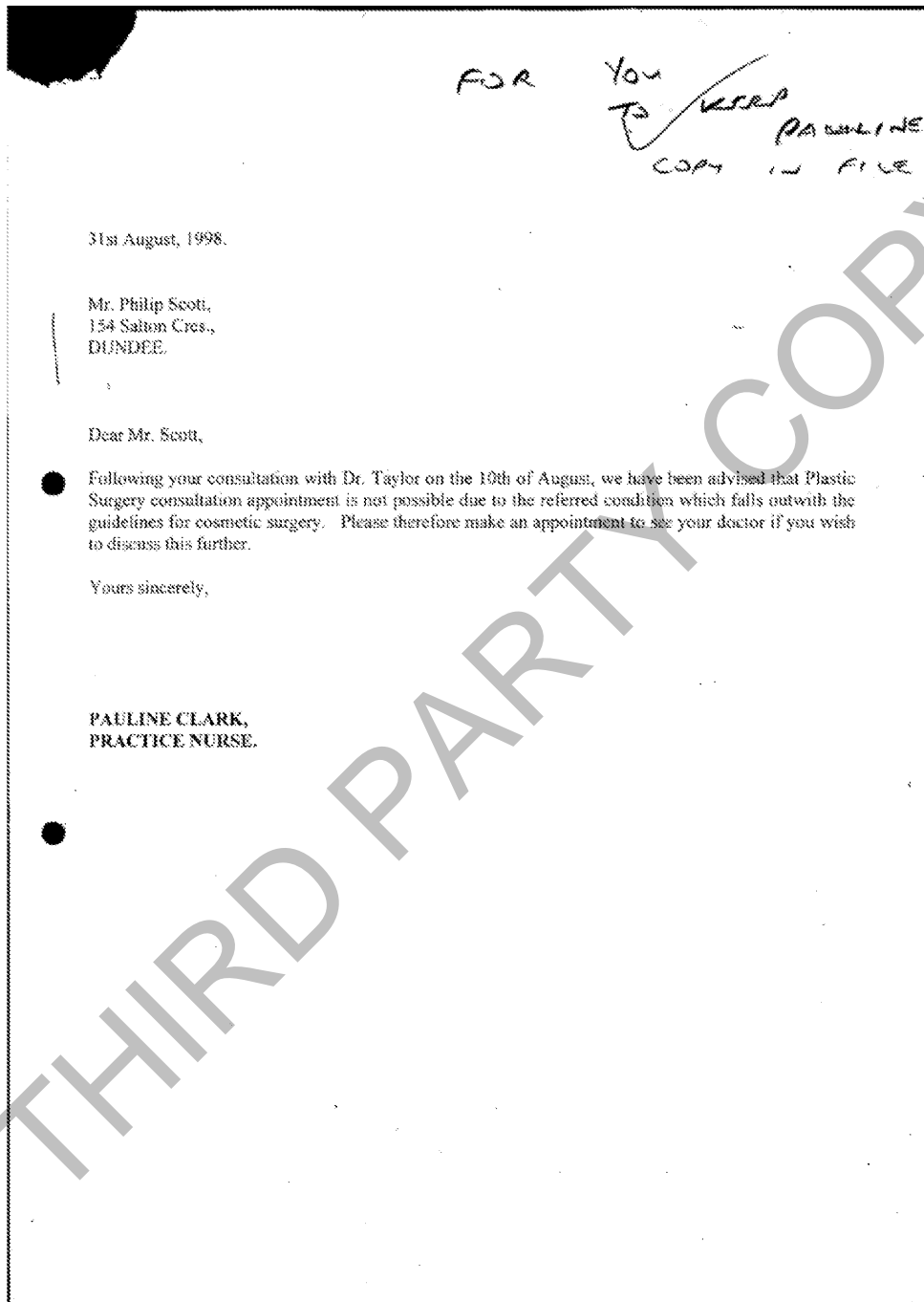

**GUIDELINES FOR PLASTIC SURGERY REFERRALS -
'COSMETIC' CASES**

The following should not normally be referred:

A Simple moles, papillomata, sebaceous cysts, which are not on the face or in other 'problem' areas

B Professional tattoos. Amateur tattoos on the hands or face may be appropriate if preventing employment or causing severe psychological distress.

C 'Cosmetic' procedures but note the exceptions:

<u>CONDITION/PROCEDURE</u>	<u>EXCEPTIONS</u>
1 'Ageing face' eg face lift, eyelids, wrinkles	Gross skin excess, eg on eyelids interfering with vision
2 Liposuction for obesity	Localised deposits/lipodystrophy
3 Small breasts (augmentation)	Asymmetry
4 Droopy breasts (mastopexy)	
5 Large breasts (reduction)	Physical symptoms
6 Rhinoplasty	Previous trauma with deformity Developmental defects
7 Loose abdominal skin	Bad scars. Extreme weight loss
8 Prominent ears	Children under 16

***NB** In addition, items 3-8 are appropriate referrals in the presence of severe psychological distress, but please document this in the referral letter or in a report from a clinical psychologist or psychiatrist. Referrals lacking this support will be replied to with a polite reminder of our policy.*



Description: facial pain

Comment: I would be grateful if you could see this 49 year old man who seems to have had issues for the last 3 or 4 years with right sided facial pain. He has been to the dentist 3 times before and had X rays and been told that there is no dental cause for it. He has constantly been taking over the counter medication. He has previously tried but not tolerated pregabalin, gabapentin and is not keen on amitriptyline. He feels the pain is in the left side of his face from his ear in to his jaw and has a sharp pain. He feels walking into the wind can trigger it. He tells me when it is not severe pain it does have tingling feeling and he is scared to eat at times because it is so painful and he avoids going out unless he has a choice as certainly cold wind will make it worse. He finds that he also has increased salivation while he is in pain. When I saw him today I wasn't able to illicit any neurological abnormalities. Given the pain and symptoms he is having and the fact that he has tried other medications, I have tried him a small dose of Carbamazepine to see if this helps however I would be grateful if you could see him for further investigations. Many thanks for your assistance.

Re: Survive and Thrive

You have recently been referred to Dundee Adult Psychological Therapies Service by your GP. Your referral details have been passed to me as I am currently focusing on identifying people who have a known history of trauma. I am able to offer these individuals the opportunity to engage in an intervention called Survive and Thrive.

Survive and Thrive is an intervention aimed specifically at people who have a history of interpersonal trauma. Interpersonal trauma is defined as having experienced any kind of childhood adversity (physical, sexual, emotional abuse or neglect, or witnessing violence within the home) or adversity as an adult (including domestic abuse, rape, stalking, or harassment). Survive and Thrive aims to help people understand how some of their day to day difficulties may be related to their history of trauma; to understand the normal range of reactions to trauma; and to develop healthy ways of coping with these difficulties. Survive and Thrive is delivered as a series of educational "classes" which take place weekly for a total of 10 weeks. There are also two follow-up appointments where your ongoing needs can be reassessed. I enclose an information sheet for you. A lot of people can feel anxious that they will be expected to talk about their own history of trauma. Survive and Thrive is **not** an opportunity to talk about what happened to you and you will **not** be asked to do this within the class setting.

If you would like to arrange an appointment to meet with me so that we can discuss your needs and suitability for attending Survive and Thrive, please contact me by telephoning Dundee Adult Psychological Therapies on **01382 346556** and we can arrange a suitable time to meet. I would be very happy to answer any questions or concerns that you may have. If you do not wish to consider attending Survive and Thrive, your name will be returned to the Waiting List (in the same place as at referral) for Dundee Adult Psychological Therapies Service and you will be invited to opt-in for an appointment once your name nears the top of the waiting list. If I have not heard from you within two weeks of the date of this letter, I will assume that you do not wish to consider attending Survive and Thrive and your name will be returned to the Waiting List as described above.

I look forward to hearing from you in due course.



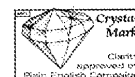

Thank you for referring this 50 year old ambidextrous man who is awaiting a PVG to become a Support Worker. Over the past 5-6 years he has been experiencing intermittent pain mostly over the left side of the face, sometimes these episodes are associated with a similar pain over the left occipital area radiating towards the top of the neck and also towards the left shoulder. He can recall going for a walk on a windy day on a beach and the cold wind triggering off the pain along the left jaw. Subsequently he had a tooth extracted but this did not make a difference. Most of the events are restricted to the left side of the face and the associated with pain over the left occipital area and shoulder appears to be rather infrequent. Since the GP commenced him on Carbamazepine 100mgs a day he has not had any further events.

Past history consists of sciatica 2009. He currently takes Carbamazepine 100mgs a day. He has no allergies. He smokes 15-20 a day and takes less than 2 units of alcohol per week.

On examination cranial nerve findings were unremarkable. Corneal reflexes were intact. Weber's and Rinne's tests were intact. He had grade 5 power with physiological tone. His reflexes were present with reinforcement in both upper limbs and without reinforcement in both lower limbs, plantar responses were flexor bilaterally. There were no cerebellar signs.

Although the distribution of his symptoms is sometimes outside that of the trigeminal nerve the trigger from the cold wind and the response to Carbamazepine indicate left sided trigeminal neuralgia. I have requested an MRI head scan and left trigeminal nerve to rule out demyelination and a vascular loop. You may wish to increase the dose of Carbamazepine if the pain breaks through. If he develops any new symptoms, please do get in touch and I would be happy to arrange a review.



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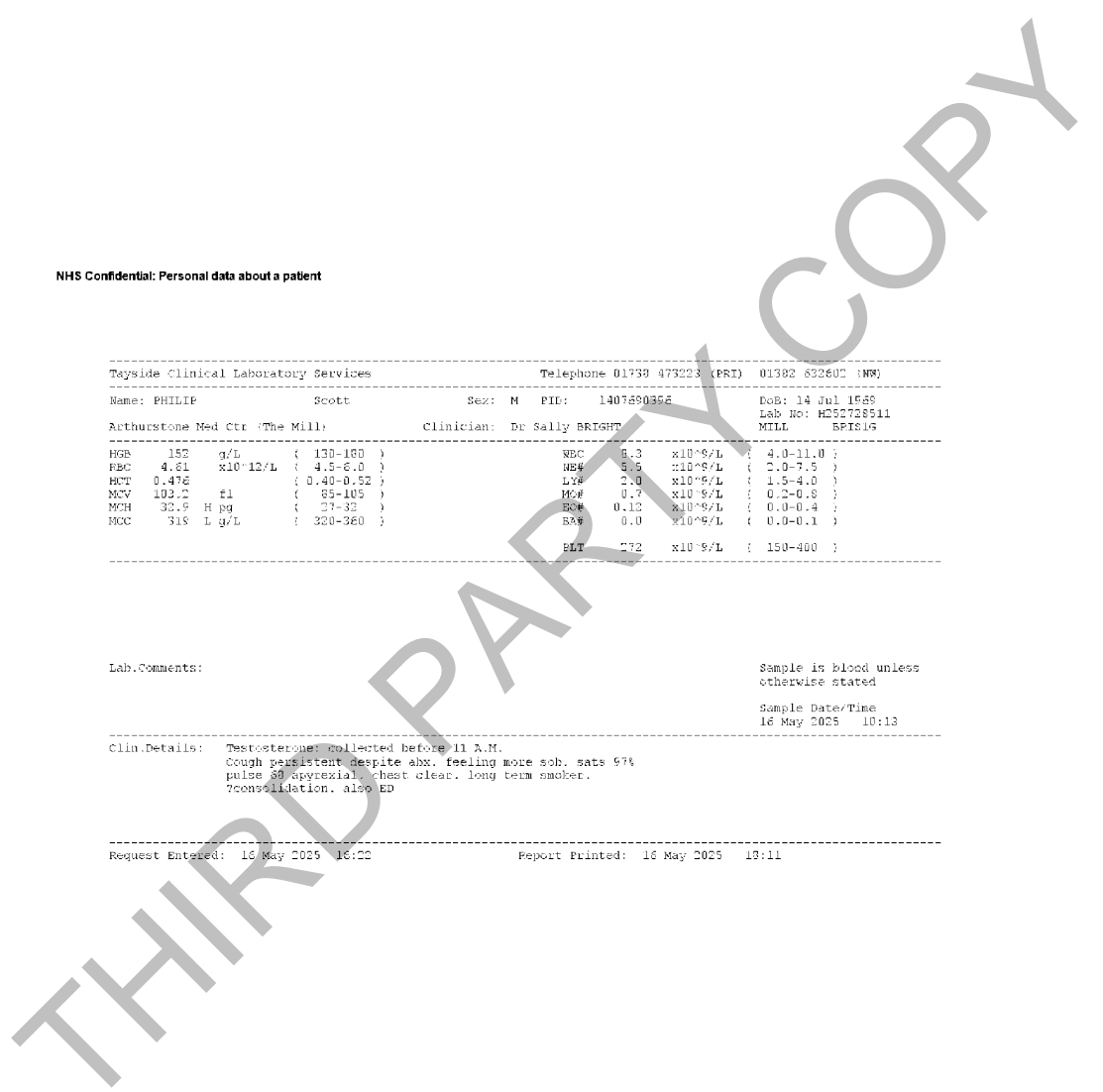
