Description: Previous Pipelle biopsy negative. Further bleeding and discharge, possible prolapse

Comment: Dear Dr Beattie You saw this patient several weeks ago and a copy of your discharge letter is attached for ease of reference. She presented again with a nine day history of fresh vaginal bleeding and two to three day history of some pain and being aware of something coming down. She has also had two episodes of dysuria/cystitis, self treated in the last four weeks. The intensity of the bleeding has increased, associated now with a discharge. I have started her on some antibiotics which previously considerably resolved the symptoms which she had . She tells me that she has received a letter from yourself that the biopsy results were negative however, given her continuing symptoms and her significant blood loss I would be most grateful if she could be urgently assessed. Thank you for seeing her.

Text: I would be grateful if you would consider urgently seeing this woman who I am concerned may have SCC on her right knee.

She lived in Australia for many years and tells me that she had a non-melanoma skin cancer removed from the left side of her nose about 10 years ago. She is not sure if it was a BCC or a SCC.

For a number of months she has been aware of a new raised lesion on her right knee. It often scabs over and she picks it off but the scab always comes back. She thinks it has slightly grown over time.

I examined her in person and she has an approx. 8-9mm slightly raised lesion on her right knee. There is a small area of ulceration at the superior aspect of the lesion which is otherwise pink in colour. It has a slightly irregular border and a faint scale. Just lateral to the lesion that appears to be a solar lentigo.

Given her history of previous history of skin cancer, exposure to significant sun in Australia and appearances of this new lesion with a small area of ulceration I am grateful for your urgent attention and assessment.

I would be grateful if you would consider seeing this lady who has been troubled with a right knee problem for some time.

She has had right knee pain for a number of months and this waxes and wanes. Generally the pain is worse on movement and sometimes her knee is a little swollen.

Recently she was getting out of her van and slid instead of taking a normal step out of the van and had a hyperextension injury to the right knee. The knee swoll up after and has felt like it is locking intermittently ever since.

On examination she has a mild knee effusion. There is significant crepitus on flexion and medial joint line tenderness. Flexion is limited to 100 degrees although she can fully extend the knee. There is no laxity on anterior drawer test. Testing of the lateral collateral ligaments shows pain over the MCL.

I think she probably has a background of OA and has aggravated this with the recent injury possibly sustaining a meniscal or MCL injury. I would be grateful for you soon attention to her to try and rehabilitate her from her recent injury and also improve some of her likely OA symptoms. I have also arranged an x-ray and given her non-steroidal anti-inflammatories.

Persistent low back pain and leg pain.

Outcome:

APP Clinic has referred to Physiotherapy and would benefit from a Pain Trained Physiotherapist.

This patient was referred following triage by the Neurosurgical Team at the Royal Infirmary. I have assessed them today within my Advanced Physiotherapy Practitioner Clinic as part of the NHS Lothian Integrated Back Pain Service.

This patient has been consulted during the current Covid 19 pandemic. The consultation has been conducted in line with relevant national guidance.

Mrs Berry is a 57-year-old lady, who has persistent back and leg pain since a fall from a horse 8 years ago in Australia. She describes her current symptoms are central low back pain radiating into the right leg, that goes down the front and back to the foot, and the same distribution on the left just to a lesser extent. She feels this is a hot burning pain with some pins and needles in her right big toe. She also has a quad bike accident a year later in Australia, but this time just injured her face.

She feels she has regular flare-ups and moved to Edinburgh 2 years ago and feels she has had six or seven big flare-ups since. These flare-ups are now happening with more trivial movements. She had a neuro modulator in place 5 years ago, that gives help, although she is starting to use this less. I believe she had a review by Dr Marples in 2001 who could not suggest any further advice around medication than she was previously on. She has also been seen by the Health Psychology. She tells me she has had physiotherapy in Australia, but nothing in Edinburgh

Pain is worse with prolonged sitting. Walking is extremely difficult and she uses a mobility scooter, standing for more than 2 or 3 minutes will bring on her symptoms. Her sleep is very broken, part of this is a restless leg type sensation. She came today with a question of what is available to help her symptoms. She is also very focused on her discs. She has high BMI and the knowledge that she now does very little exercises and tends to over eat.

Her BMI is 39. She has constipation and had previous surgery on her feet. She was seen in A&E due to some cauda equina concerns, although on speaking to her today, she has normal working of bladder and bowels other than the constipation, and no saddle numbness.

CT scan shows compression at L5 nerve root on the right, with the left L3 and S1 also having some compression.

I note the patient's past medical history and drug history as per the GP referral and have confirmed with the patient that this is accurate and up to date.

I was unable to undertake a physical exam due to remote consultation. I note assessment in A&E on 8th April shows normal power, sensation and reflexes, with some decrease in

sensation.

Mrs Berry has persistent back and leg pain. I have explained that I think surgery would be highly unlikely given the length of nature of her symptoms, along with dominant low back pain and a high BMI. I have explained that physiotherapy is unlikely to take the pain away, but is more placed to help try and manage her symptoms. It would be to try and look at lifestyle factors such as weight and diet, also encouraging some general activity and strengthening through the spine.

I have reassured her regarding her examination in A&E and her CT scan, and the importance of exercises for the health of the disc. I have directed her to websites for understanding and managing persistent back pain, such as "Tame the Beast" and the "Pain Tool Kit".

She would benefit from seeing a Pain Trained Physiotherapist.
