On 30.10.74, at the request of the R.S.S.P.C.C, Miss Hutton, social worker, and myself visited 12 Isla Street, Dundee, the home of Mrs. Markie, the children's maternal grandmother. The two-roomed apartment was dirty and there was an open fire in one room, with no fireguard.

According to Mrs. Markie, Mrs. Andrews, the children's mother, left the children with her on 6 October 1974, asking her to baby-sit for the evening. She did not return, and it is understood that she is now living in Manchester. However, she has written to Mrs. Markie, indicating that she intends to return to Dundee, to collect [redacted] only.

In view of these facts and the information in the R.S.S.P.C.C. report, it is considered appropriate to request that this case be brought to a Children's Hearing.

Area Social Worker with view to children being dirty, but pronounced adequately fit. However, according to [redacted] (M. James Children Home) the children have been in poor health since they arrived at an unsuitable date.

The above children are presently subject to Supervision Requirements under Sec. 44 (1) (a) Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968. The orders were last reviewed on 7th March, 1979. Unfortunately, since then, there have been several events which have given rise to some concern about the care of the children. On 27th March, the family moved from 43 Dunmore Street, Dundee without Mrs. Andrews notifying this Department, even although the family had been visited the previous day. Through my own investigations, I learned that the family had moved in with Mr. [redacted] [redacted] Dundee. On 12th April, there was an incident near the grandmother's home when the children witnessed a row between Mrs. Andrews and Mr. [redacted]. The children were upset. The police were called but I understand no charges were brought against either party. Immediately, Mrs. Markie, the children's grandmother, took them to St. Francis' Children's Home and she requested that the children be taken into care. They remained in care for 4 days until Mrs. Andrews and Mr. Bremner removed them, against advice from this Department.

Needless to say, such events have had a distressing effect on the children and it would seem appropriate that a Hearing be arranged in the near future to review the home situation. Mrs. Andrews states that she would like Mr. [redacted] to accompany her to any Hearing. They are both at the address in Cheviot Crescent, as above.

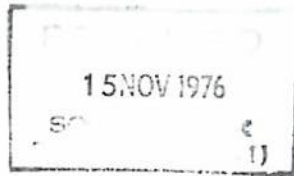
