Description: Left sided chest pain

Comment: Thank you for seeing this 42 year old gentleman who complains of left sided chest pain/upper quadrant pain. This would all seem to have been triggered since an RTA many years ago although he was not significantly injured but the seatbelt positioning would appear to follow the line of his pain. It does not sound cardiac in nature at all. He has now been seen twice by the Surgeon and when he was initially seen in 2009 he had a CT scan which did not show anything significant other than a small lipoma deep to the left latissimus dorsi muscle. The pain would appear to be triggered primarily by exercise such as lifting his children. It responds slightly to Tramadol but not significantly he is still left with some degree of pain. It is disturbing his sleep. The Surgeons feel they have nothing more to offer and have suggested that he may benefit from input from yourselves. He is agreeable to being seen.

In the meantime he is having a trial of Nortriptyline having previously been on Amitriptyline, Carbamazepine and Gabapentin none of which have helped significantly. Many thanks for your help.

Clinical problem: Left upper quadrant pain for the last 6 years

I reviewed this gentleman in the clinic today. We had initially reviewed him in the clinic in 2009 with similar pain and he subsequently underwent a CT scan, which did not show anything significant. He had a small lipoma deep to the left latissimus dorsi muscle. Since then he still seems to have this pain occasionally and takes regular Tramadol for this.

On examination today he is still slightly tender below his left ribs, but nil else of note.

Having had a normal CT and routine normal bloods, I am not sure I can offer anything surgically for this gentleman. I have explained to him that although he had a nominal whiplash injury other things need to be considered are back related issues or musculo skeletal issues. I think this gentleman would benefit from a referral to the Pain Team to see if this helps as his pain seems to be predominately during night time and not during the day.

I am discharging him back to your care, but please refer him back if any other issues crop up,

Many thanks for referring this gentleman. He has had chronic left upper quadrant pain now for two and half to three years. There are no specific exacerbating or relieving factors and the pain does not keep him from working. His bowel habit is completely normal with no recent changes. His weight is static and his appetite is good. The pain first presented about six months after he was involved in a RTA and I note that he had a CT scan of his chest a year ago to investigate the same symptoms with no abnormality identified. In the first instance I will arrange for him to have a CT scan of his abdomen. It is possible that he sustained a diaphragmatic rupture after his RTA or he may have uncommon conditions like a splenic cyst however I think it likely that his scan will be normal.

History:

His pain started off by itself a couple of years ago. He had had an RTA about a year and a half before that with some bruising to the ribs, but no trouble in the intervening time. It feels constant and dull in the left lower ribs. It is not usually bad when he wakes up, but then it comes on during the day. It can go up to his chest or to under his scapula. Sometimes it goes down to his stomach. It is not guided by exercise or movement but can disturb his sleep a bit if he lies on his left hand side.

He has had quite a lot of investigations including CT scan which did not show any problems.

Treatment:

He takes Tramadol 50 mg 6 times a day – only takes the edge off the pain.
Acupuncture by a Nurse in his practice – helped for a couple of days.

Thank you for referring this gentleman regarding his left sided chest pain.

The patient tells me today that he has had left sided chest pain for the last 12 months. The pain is mainly over the left lower ribs. It sometimes radiate up to the front of the chest as well. He has not noticed any activity or anything which causes the pain to be worse.

He has been on painkillers for his pain including Diclofenac, Tramadol and Amitriptyline which have helped to some extent.

The patient had a car accident about 2 years ago which left him with a lot of bruising and pain along the seat belt side which did not last long.

His past medical history includes pharyngo-laryngeal reflux for which he is taking Omeprazole. He has been to hospital several times where he had his left sided chest pain investigated but could not find any cause for it.

On examination the patient is overweight. He has tenderness over the left lower ribs with pain increasing on aspiration. No tenderness over the front of the chest. No tenderness over the sternoclavicular joint, over his shoulder, c. spine or the left scapula. He has a full range of movements in his left shoulder as well as his neck. No clinical evidence of winging of his scapula. He has good power in all his muscles involved in his left upper limb as well as trunk. He notices that abduction and internal rotation of his left upper arm exacerbates his pain. The patient also pointed out that he has a lump or swelling over the left lower rib although it was quite difficult to palpate.

/....

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Following discussion with Mr. Sharma, Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon we decided to request a MRI scan to investigate this lump to make sure there is no other pathology. His pain which is exacerbated by abduction and internal rotation might suggest that he has sprain of the latissimus dorsi insertion but we will wait for the MRI scan report first before jumping to any conclusions.

Plan – patient to be reviewed back in the clinic with the MRI scan report.

Description: Left chest wall and left hypochondrial pains.

Comment: I would appreciate any help you can give with diagnosing this man's left chest wall and left hypochondrial pains which I believe to be musculo skeletal in origin. He initially attended in August 2007 with pain over the left anterior chest wall, initially just lateral to the sternum and described as a burning pain. He has had some benefit from Omeprazole but I am sure this is not an ulcer pain he is getting.

Investigations: His full blood count showed a mild neutrophilia with the presence of cold agglutinins treated with Clarithromycin 500mg twice daily. I would suggest follow up with full blood count in 10-14 days time.

Progress: His monospot was negative and the possibility of mycoplasma infection is probably worthwhile completing the treatment which is noted as below.

Recommended Treatment: Clarithromycin 500mg bd for one week.

Follow up: Nil.
