Supplementary Report

Lee has now been a pupil of Kerelaw School for some six months since December of last year and for much of the time has not presented as being a problem either for the school or for his family. Until Easter of this year he had managed to maintain himself at the school and had established a leave pattern which allowed him extended leave at weekends and the plan was to allow him to be at home one evening mid week each week. Lee was home during the Easter school holiday break and there were no problems.

It was upon his return to school after the Easter break that he almost immediately absconded from the school. During April he absconded several times and for a large part of the month he was not at Kerelaw. It was during this time that he was involved in further offending.

Lee had initially complained that he was being "bullied" by other boys within the unit and staff at Kerelaw took appropriate steps to ensure that this stopped. It seemed, however, impossible to reassure Lee that he would not be pressurised by other boys when he returned to Kerelaw. He essentially kept returning to Maybole and, while his parents refused to harbour him and did report to the Police each occasion when he returned home, Lee continues to feel a sense of security in being in vicinity of his family.

Lee is again unable to explain his actions and continues to present as a very complex but immature character. He returned to Kerelaw at the beginning of May and has remained there for the last month, presenting no problems and in fact I have been getting positive reports from staff regarding his behaviour.

At a review held at Kerelaw School on 28th May 1991 it was decided that Lee had to learn to operate within the boundaries of Kerelaw and that meant that he also had to be able to come home on leave without becoming involved in further offending. It was also decided that a very firm structure had to be imposed in relation to his activities and leave pattern. Good behaviour will be rewarded by home leave, however, this has to be earned and can and will be withdrawn should Lee's standard of behaviour fall below what is expected of him. A leave pattern during the summer will have to be by a process of negotiation following assessment of his behaviour.

Clearly Lee would not be able to cope with a return to mainstream schooling, however, it is recognised that with support and structure he can function without offending. It is therefore, to be hoped that it will be possible to move towards Lee at some point attending Kerelaw as a day boy. This would have the advantage of him having successfully completed a period where he was at home prior to the time when he leaves school. Our efforts, therefore, must concentrate on altering his behaviour pattern prior to him reaching the age of sixteen. Structure and support will be provided by school and by the writer and it is hoped that the unsettled period in the month of April will not re-occur.

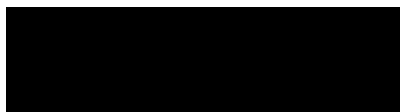

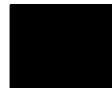

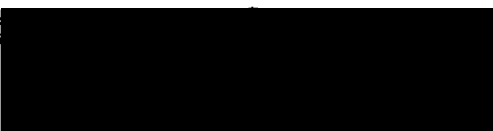

I enclose, herewith, Form CH 194 duly completed. Lee was received into the care of the local authority under Section 44(1)(b) of the Social Work (Scotland) Act 1968 on 1st November 1990.

He was admitted to Kerelaw School, Stevenston on 19th December 1990. It is not intended, however, that links with the home should be broken and indeed the family play an integral part in the treatment plan for this boy. Lee, therefore, comes home every weekend and is at home from Friday afternoon until Monday morning. It would be our intention to further extend the leave pattern to allow Lee to be at home midweek in addition to the weekends at home.

I trust that this clarifies the position with regard to child benefit.

At the request of Mrs. Marion Stewart, Assistant Area Reporter, I carried out a psychiatric examination of the above named 14 year old male at Seafeld Hospital, Out-Patient Department on 16.11.90.

I had seen this boy before with his mother on several occasions in 1988 when he was 9 years old. At that time he had a behaviour problem and was prone to play truant and engage in stealing.

In the intervening years it is clear that his personality has become more anti-social. He is not suffering from any kind of mental illness nor does he have any deep seated emotional problems. He has no anxiety or concern about his long list of misdemeanours and he is not at all sure that he will be able to keep from offending if he is in the community. He has no real motivation to change.

He told me he did not like Redbrae School. He feels more positive about the suggestion that he may be placed in Keweenaw List D School.

I do not think psychiatric treatment will change this lad's personality or behaviour. The outlook for good stable behaviour, free of offending, is not very good.

He does require placement in a residential setting.

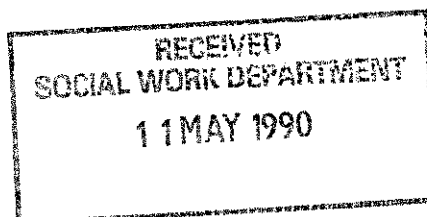

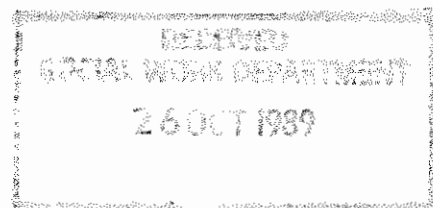

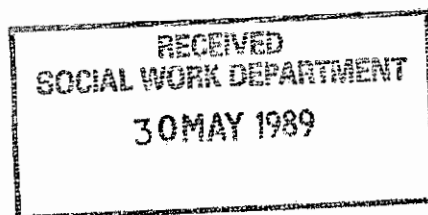

EVENTS LEADING TO THE EXCLUSION OF LEE JOHNSTONE FROM CARRICK ACADEMY
ON THURSDAY 8 DECEMBER 1988.

25 NOVEMBER

Lee was pushing and jostling [REDACTED] who sat behind him in the French class.

Lee pushed and kicked Craig as he went into the English class. Craig was in tears and had to be removed from the class to calm him down.

The class all said that he did this without any reason.

Lee's Self Assessment Timetable was not signed period 1.

He scored out the comment which was written by a teacher.

6 DECEMBER

Called [REDACTED] a 'whore' - this was done in front of many other pupils.

7 DECEMBER

Caught throwing stones at the community wing - towards windows and on to the roof.

Scored out entry on Behaviour Timetable - issued with punishment exercise which has not been completed.

8 DECEMBER

Continually blew 'raspberries' while the teacher was working at the board. When put outside he made faces in the window on the door. When told to move along the corridor he refused to move.

Referred to Principal Teacher - when given instruction and asked if he understood he turned his head away and ignored the Principal Teacher.

Behaviour Timetable not signed by parents on Tuesday 6 December and Wednesday 7 December.

All of these were admitted by Lee in front of myself and an Assistant Head Teacher.

I have also attached the incidents and pattern of behaviour relating to the previous exclusion on Thursday 27 October 1988.

REASONS

- Final Incidents 26 October - Punishment exercise given in Art - not done for 26 October.
Completed in school and then not signed by father.
Misbehaviour in corridor of school building - hitting a window with a badminton racket. Given a punishment exercise.
- 27 October - Did not return punishment exercise 'had left it at home'. Told to report to Assistant Head Teacher at lunchtime. Failed to turn up - gave no reason when questioned.
- 27 October - Disrupted Geography lesson by constantly interrupting by talking, shouting and carrying on. When reprimanded he said the teacher was 'an old bog'.

Previous record in Carrick Academy

- 26 August - Excluded for swearing in class and threatening the pupils in the class.
- 3 October - Threatening and punching other pupils.
- 7 October - Readmitted to school.
- Wilfully breaking the glass on the fire alarm and setting off the alarm throughout the school - Lee also told other boys that he had lit paper in the toilet.
- 14 October - Father signed written guarantee of Lee's future behaviour.
